Response for 2011

Increase of 157 Calls for Service (Citizen)

- **Total Incidents 2011: 14,939**
 - **Calls For Service (CFS): 7,028 (47%)**
 - **On-View (OV): 7,911 (53%)**

- **Total Incidents 2010: 15,882**
 - **CFS: 6,871 (43%)**
 - **OV: 9,011 (57%)**

Response for 2011

- **A decrease of 943 incidents
(1100 fewer On View Incidents)**
- **Percent Change from 2010 to 2011**
 - **Total Incidents: -5.9%**
 - **CFS: +2.3%**
 - **OV: -12.2%**
 - **Population: est. 27,000 (03/14/12) +64%

Analysis Highlights for 2011

- **A decrease of 943 incidents overall(-5.9%)**
 - **Result of Reducing the number of beats**
 - **Traffic Stops decreased by 9% from 2010 (2068) to 2011 (1890)**
 - **Citations decreased from 4921 to 4557**
- **CFS increased by 2.3% from 2010 (6,871) to 2011 (7,028)**
 - **Slight estimated population increase (from 26,536 to 27,000)**
 - **Increased CFS will reduce ability to conduct officer initiated activity (Proactive efforts)**
 - **7% increase in total number of reports (DR's) taken (2,095 in 2010 and 2,250 in 2011). Increased amount of time to conclude events = less time for proactive patrol.**
 - **Shoplifting Reports Taken increased by 78% (from 94 to 167)**
 - **Runaway Juveniles increased by 48% (from 88 to 130)**
 - **Reports Taken for Vehicle Accidents increased by 26% from 411 to 519 (Non-injury Accidents increased from 314 to 394 and Injury related increased from 97 to 125)**



Uniform Crime Report

- **The Uniform Crime Report or UCR is a standardized system for the collection and reporting of crime statistics administered by the U.S. Federal Bureau of Investigation.**
- **Within the UCR, Part I crimes consist of the following:**
 - **Crimes Against Persons:**
 - Homicide, Sexual Assault, Robbery, Aggravated Assault
 - **Crimes Against Property:**
 - Burglary, Theft, Auto Theft and Arson



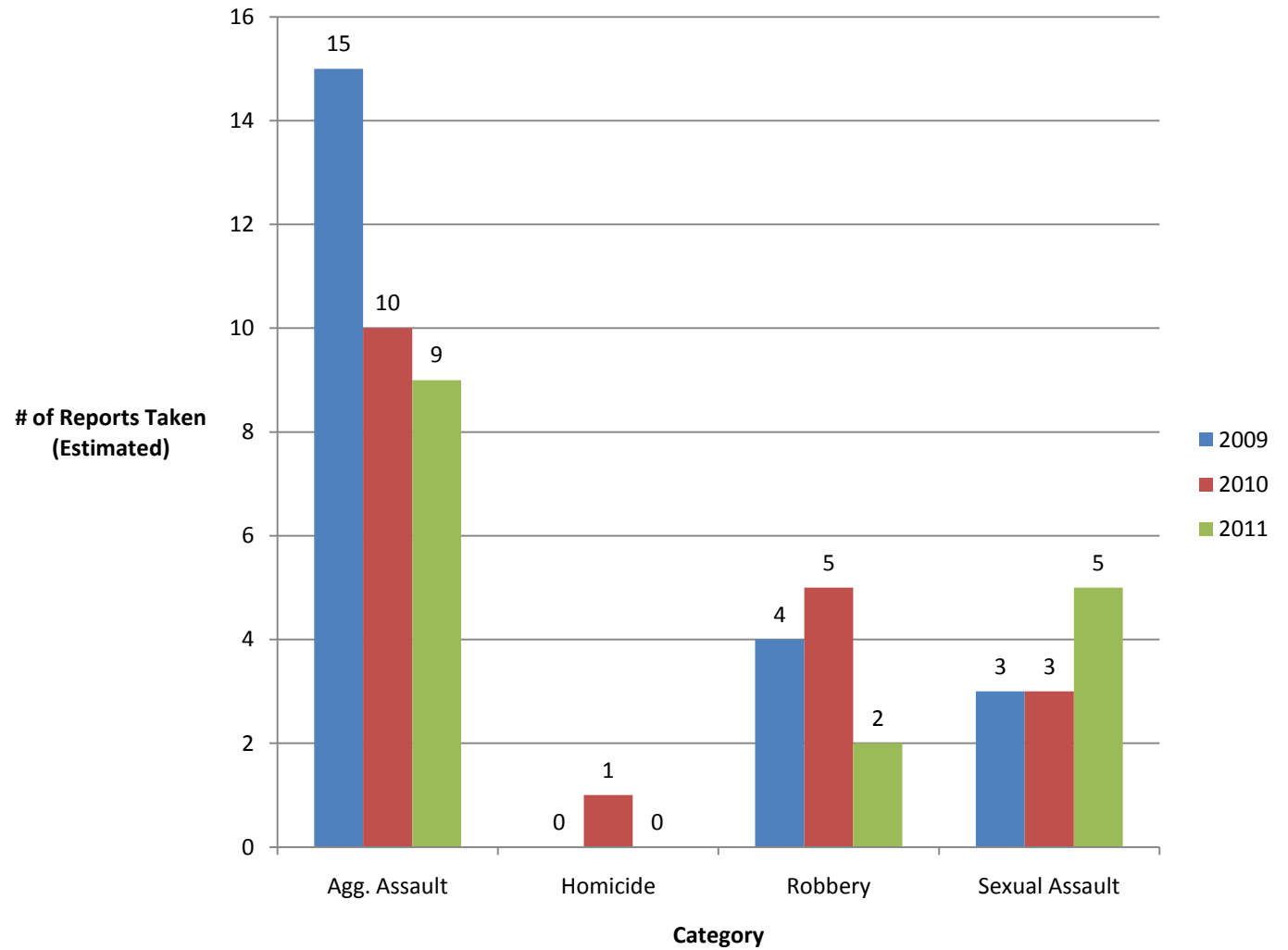

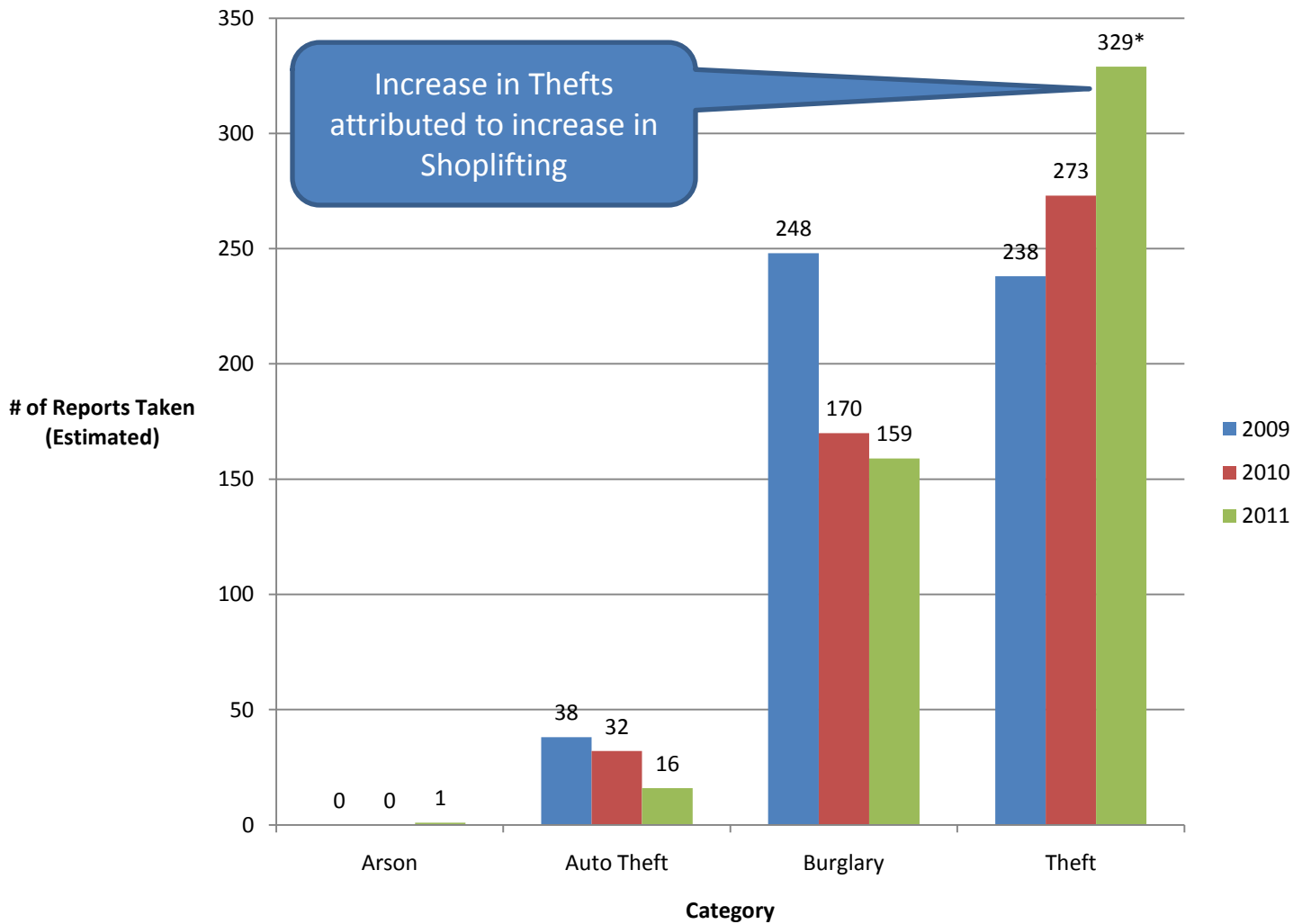


Index Crimes - Against Person

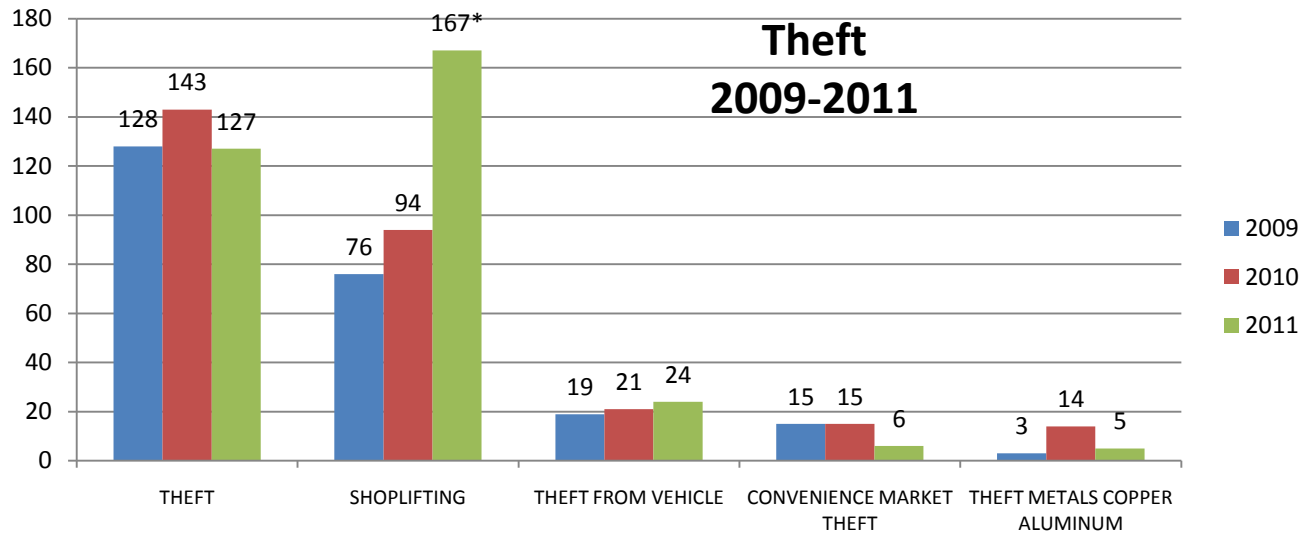




Index Crimes - Against Property

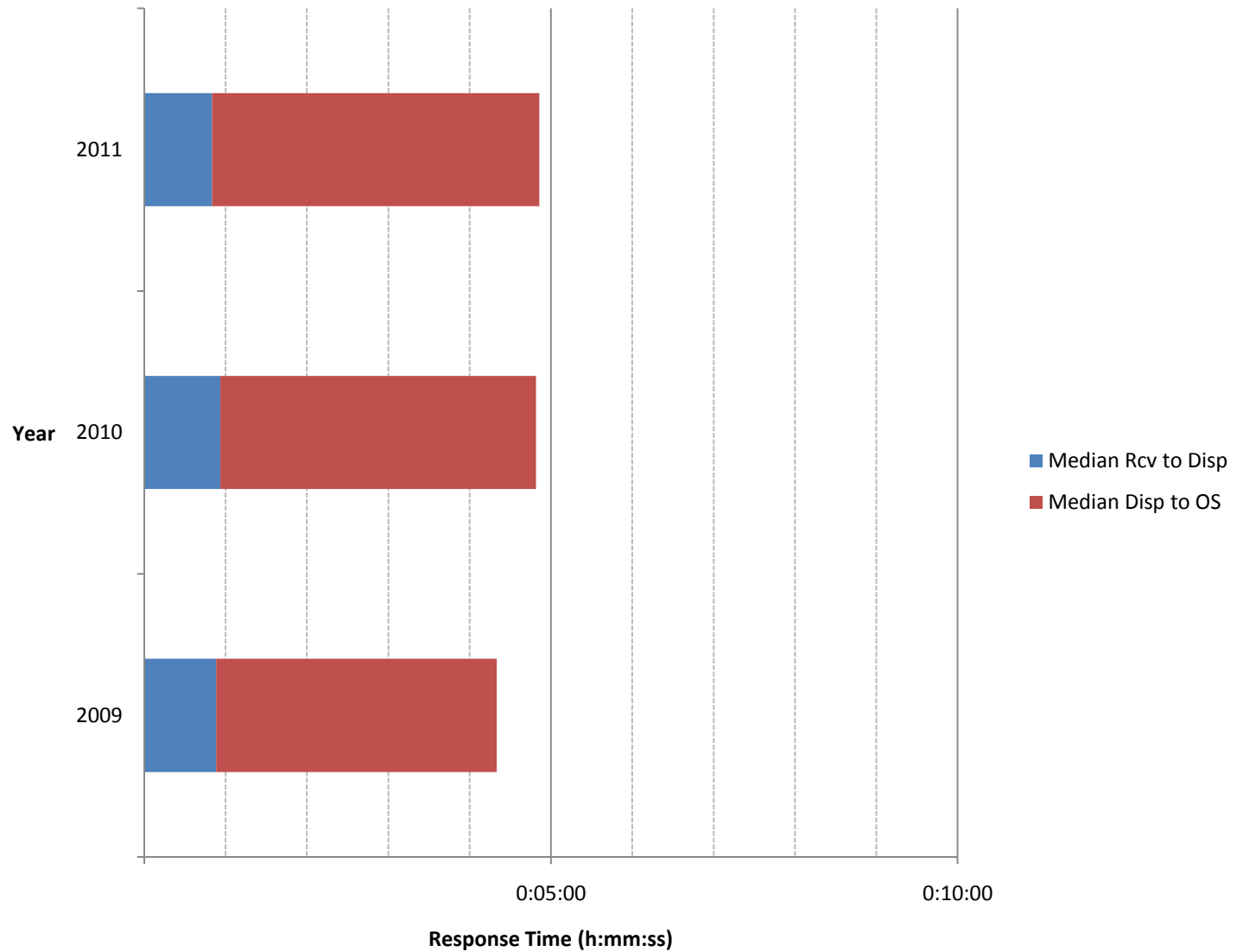
