### NATURE

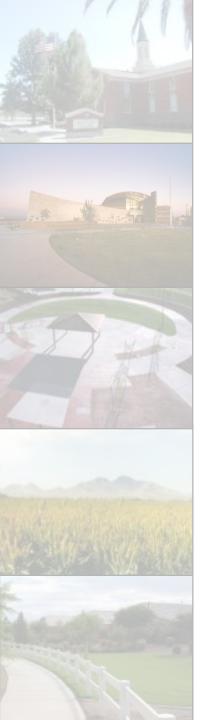
