HHW

- Household Products
 - Corrosive
 - Toxic
 - Ignitable
 - Reactive
- Disposal Concerns
 - Down the drain
 - On the ground
 - Storm system
 - Trash carts









Town's Current Program

- Limited
 - Special Drop-off Collection Events
 - Tires, Electronics, Metals
 - Website Information
 - Batteries
 - Motor Oil/Antifreeze
 - Paint
 - Refrigerators
 - Light Bulbs/Fluorescent Lights
 - Tires
 - Earth911.com



HHW Disposal Options

Curbside Pickup – Glendale

- Bi-annual, scheduled pick-up
- First 750 households (population 226,000)
- Contracted service

Collection Events – Mesa

- Two Events Two Locations 8am-noon
- East Mesa Service Ctr (Oct 27, 2012 / Feb 9, 2013)
- Center St Facility (Dec 8, 2012 / Apr 20, 2013)

Scheduled HHW Facility Use – Chandler

- HHW drop-off by appt only by phone
- In-house staff



Proposed Pilot Program IGA – Town of Gilbert

- HHW Facility Use Voucher System
- Hours of Operation
 - Wed & Fri 9am-3pm
 - Sat 7am-1pm
- Voucher required
 - 70 lbs limit
- First come, first serve
 - 25 Vouchers per month maximum/300 annually
 - Some flexibility for priority move-outs
- Fees
 - \$75 per vehicle for regular HHW
 - \$65 per vehicle for reduced cost HHW

Acceptable Materials Regular HHW

- Automobile Tires (limit 5 per hh)
- Batteries/light bulbs
- Computers electronics
- Household Cleaners
- Pesticides
- Pool Chemicals
- Propane Tanks
- Motor Oil
- Paints/Stains/Varnishes/Solvents/Thinners
- Adhesives



Acceptable Materials Reduced Cost HHW (smaller quantities)

- Motor Oil
- Antifreeze
- Electronic waste
- Scrap metal
- Usable latex paint
- Cell Phones
- Cooking Oil



Unacceptable Materials

- Commercial Waste
- Appliances
- Ammunition/Fireworks
- Explosive Material
- Home-Generate Medical Waste
- Prescription Drugs
- Radioactive Waste
- Items in Plastic Trash Bags
- Commercial Vehicle Tires



Budget/Planning

- FY12/13 Budget \$22,500
 - Sufficient funds available for 300 users
 - Residential needs are unknown
- FY13/14 Budget Planning
 - Review pilot program use and demand
 - Review mix-use options
 - Formal plan for FY13/14
