The Town has actively participated as a stakeholder in the development of the study.




# MAG Commuter Rail Study

- Prior to work beginning on the ADOT Passenger Rail Corridor Study, the Maricopa Association of Governments completed a Commuter Rail System Study.
- The Study, adopted by the MAG Regional Council in 2010, identified a corridor in the East Valley as having the highest potential and that which should be constructed first should funding be identified for a commuter rail system.
- While the commuter rail study dealt with a different type of rail than the ADOT passenger rail study. The corridor selected for passenger rail will likely me the same corridor a commuter rail system would operate on.




# **Corridor Prioritization: Segment #1**
