




CIP Supplemental Request


- August 21 Council Retreat- Council requested work study item on implementing Ellsworth Road improvement project.
- At this time town staff recommends implementing the Ellsworth Road project along with four (5) other transportation related projects.
- The recommended projects are estimated to cost a combined \$10M and will be completed in phases over the next 1-3 years.




Capital Improvement Program – Current Projects




Capital Improvement Program - Recommended Projects



Capital Improvement Program – Rittenhouse Road




Capital Improvement Program – Ocotillo Road and UPRR






Capital Improvement Program – Ellsworth Road
