



# SRP- Aesthetic Funds Program Guidelines

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#### What is the Aesthetic Program?

An SRP partnership program with local municipalities that offers the opportunity to have aesthetic improvements made to existing and new SRP water and power distribution, transmission, and substation facilities.



#### Qualifying Uses:

- Undergrounding 12KV/69KV
- Replacing Wood Poles with Steel Poles
- Installing walls, landscaping, sidewalk, and driveway improvements to substations
- Upgrading SRP water canals and well sites

#### Non-Qualifying Uses:

- SRP facilities solely for commercial, industrial or residential customers
- Secondary facilities (600V or less)
- Moving like services
- Private Lighting
- Land acquisitions



Program Funding:

- Administered by SRP
- Funding based on .8% of annual gross revenues or \$12 million (whichever is less)
- Total program funds can carry-over but are capped at \$40 million
- Municipal Aesthetic funds can only carryforward three fiscal years of funding (beginning May 2015)
- Annual municipal share is based on municipal's percentage share of SRP's total electrical facilities (9%) and municipal's share of SRP's cost of electrical system work accomplished during the prior fiscal year (81%).

Queen Creek Past Uses:

- 2006 Screening walls for SRP substation (\$485,000)
- 2006 Underground 300' of 12 KV at Ellsworth Road and the Queen Creek Wash (\$125,000)
- 2009 Underground 12 KV for Sonoqui Wash improvements along Hawes Road (\$123,200)


