## Ellsworth Road Improvement Project, Ocotillo to Rittenhouse

Design for the Ellsworth Road Improvement Project, from Ocotillo Road to Rittenhouse Road, will be updated to prepare for construction. The original design was completed in 2011; however, construction was unable to be funded. The Town did construct interim improvements at that time, and received a grant for the Victoria Lane widening, which was also constructed.

Ellsworth Road Improvements include decorative traffic signal lights, decorative pedestrian and street lights and installation of benches and trash receptacles within this corridor. The sidewalks will be meandering variable width construction with areas of exposed aggregate and rock in the greenbelt to appear to be a creek flowing through the area (the "Arroyo" theme). An area with flat median will incorporate stamped asphalt to appear to be brick pavers as installed in the raised median areas. Concrete on the project will be stained as well.

Provided below are draft concepts for Ellsworth Road, with construction currently scheduled to begin in early 2014 and take approximately six months to complete.





## **Overview of Current Projects**



Road to Queen Creek Marketplace (just west of Ellsworth Loop Road), will be

widened to a five-lane major arterial roadway

with two lanes in each direction and a center lane. Improvements will include street lighting, bike lanes, sidewalk, and landscaping. Design should be

Ocotillo Road and Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR)
Project: Improvements will take place on Ocotillo
Road at the UPRR crossing to construct two additional

Ocotillo Road, Ellsworth Loop to Heritage Loop, Project: Improvements will widen Ocotillo Road to five lanes (two lanes in each direction, with a center turn lane), with bike lanes and sidewalk;

construction of a new intersection at Ellsworth Road, and new traffic signal at the Heritage Loop intersection.

This project is currently in conceptual design with three alternatives under consideration. Detailed design will follow, and construction for this project is tentatively estimated to begin in 2014.
