





# Outreach to H20 Customers

- Welcome letters from the Town to H20 customers : Letters being mailed to H20 customers on October 15, 21<sup>st</sup>
- Special Water bill insert for H20 customers November 4<sup>th</sup> first bill from Town
- H20 bill October 1<sup>st</sup> Includes letter regarding Acquisition and transition
- Public Notification on Town Website, Plus H20 Website redirects H20 customers to Towns Website on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>
- Auto pay customer notifications
- H20 Phone Number will have message redirecting customers to Town's phone number
- New work stations added at front counter and a new bank of phone lines added for increased volume of calls, plus 3 new Customer Service Reps hired
- Over 50 due diligence items completed or near completion for H20 acquisition
- Auto dialer will contact past due H20 customers starting in December no lock outs anticipated until late January early February
