FY 13/14 Work Plan

Priority 1

- Develop a recommendation to Town Council regarding providing a parks development plan for consideration as part of the Town's CIP project list.
- Develop an annual survey for Youth Sports Partnerships to ensure a lasting and positive working relationship
- Create a schedule of programs/activities that provide committee members an opportunity to volunteer, evaluate, and gain citizen input on the Town's recreation services.

Priority 2

- Finalize a Facility Use Policy for Desert Mountain Park, Founders Park, and the Library Recreation Annex, including a code of conduct covering all rentals, partners and users.
- Develop and finalize policy for use of the concession stands in Town parks; both for Youth Sports Partnership seasons and general rentals.
- Review the current schedule of fees for facility rentals to determine price points and usage; comparisons to other cities/towns and any local comparable "competition".

Priority 3

- Develop a Procedure for Temporary Religious Displays as they pertain to Town parks and open space
- Review the current Memorials and Monuments Donation policy.
- Develop recommendations to Town Council regarding the Dog Park project; design/layout and park rules/regulations.
- Develop recommendations to Town Council regarding the Splash Park project; assist in reviewing proposals.
