**AGENDA**

The town is updating the General Plan. For the past eleven months, the town has been asking residents and others their opinions about what the town should maintain and what should be changed as the town grows over the next 20 years. Citizen participation in the update process is important to Town leaders and vital to ensure that the General Plan realizes the vision of the Town's residents.

Using information collected at earlier open houses, as well as from the Town Web site, letters and other input, three alternative land use concepts were developed and presented for public review and comments. The concepts were presented to the Planning and Zoning Commission and Town Council for their comments. "Alternative D" is the conceptual land use plan that was reviewed by Town Council on Dec. 19 and proposed to be the Town's new draft land use plan. Come to the open house on January 23.
