### Item B: Discuss Scheduled Day of TAC Meetings

### Item C: Update on CIP Projects

Dick commented on Terry's presentation at the last meeting, not much has changed since then.

• Two sewer jobs: one at Queen Creek/Hawes and in one week another project will start on Chandler Heights. The Rittenhouse sewer will go to Council next week, at the end of the month we may have four projects starting up.

The question has been asked as to whether a portion of the Ellsworth Loop Road will be opened this fall?

Dick – We will be looking into that. We wanted the rubber down so we could possibly open this fall. The contractor said that maybe we should concentrate our efforts on the south bound side and open just the south bound side. We are discussing it in house and will be discussing more with the contractors tomorrow.

Mike P – There is a piece on the south end up to Rittenhouse; it doesn't really go anywhere. We would have to do signing, but it will be very difficult to keep it safe with signs. Portions of the Loop road are confusing to open a piece at a time and people won't understand by signs.

Robin asked if Rittenhouse behind the Wescor project will be open by Thanksgiving. Dick stated it should be done, it is on the schedule.

# Item D: ITS System Presentation

Mike Pacelli went over the ITS presentation.

A few members asked about the small white cameras on top of the signal light arms. Mike informed the group that they are used to detect when vehicles are waiting at a light. It is a live feed and no video is recorded, thus people can't use them as evidence in traffic accidents. They are not for law enforcement, they are for traffic management.

The Town has requested funds for 2013 to buy the missing link so we can talk to other City's systems (fiber connections). Mesa and Gilbert have a system and are working on a connection. Once we connect with Gilbert, we will have a connection with Mesa through Gilbert.

- Consideration and possible approval of a contract with Ergon Asphalt to apply a fog seal to certain Town roads.
- Consideration and possible acceptance of a proposal from G&G Construction to mill and remove asphalt on abandoned portions of Rittenhouse Road.
- Consideration and possible acceptance of a proposal from G&G Construction to construct sidewalk in Roman Estates.

# Item F: Project Status on Ellsworth Loop

The railroad has moved and they are excavating, the first pour will be in two weeks. They are close to pouring the concrete for the bridge. Don informed the members that the town turned on the 15<sup>th</sup> traffic signal today at Chandler Heights and Hawes. That makes 14 additional signals since last December.

Robin commented on feedback he has received from the public; that people are happy with the improvement of traffic flow.
