#### Item B: MAG Presentation Bob Hazlett

He also informed members that he believed all the issues were resolved and the project could resume on the following Monday. The opening of the south end will alleviate traffic on Ellsworth Road; hopefully the intersection of Ellsworth/Rittenhouse Road will have improved traffic flow.

He informed members that the town is evaluating all projects and impacts if staff does not proceed with projects.
