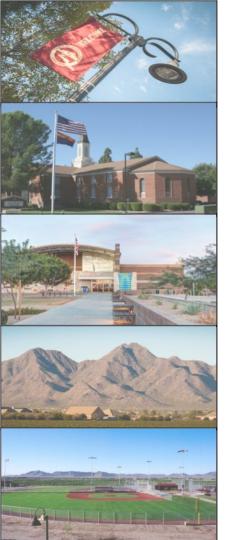


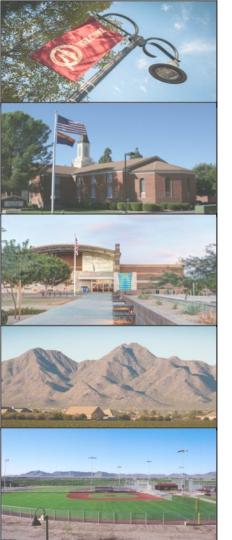
Discussion and possible action on a suicide prevention awareness community discussion

Suicide Prevention Awareness Community Discussion

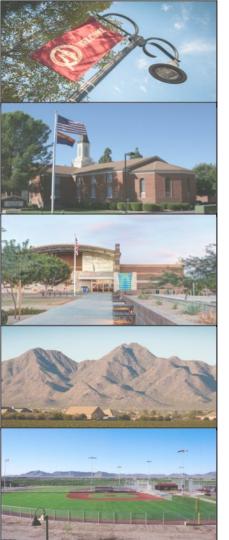
- The Town could sponsor a community-wide suicide prevention awareness discussion to supplement the school districts' efforts.
- A partner, such as Banner Hospital, would provide expert speakers to lead the community in a one hour discussion.
- Costs associated with the event are estimated to be approximately \$500 in staff time.



Alternatives

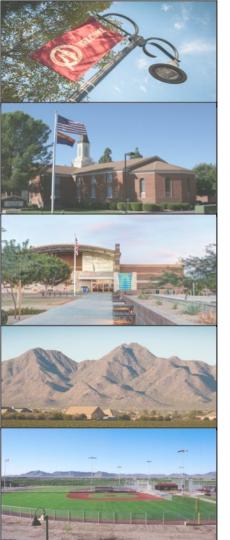
1. Take no action at this time.

 Instead of a stand alone event, partner with the Queen Creek School District to provide a presentation at a council meeting. Continue to include the various school districts' events in the Town e-newsletter and social media.



Alternatives

- 3. Community Conversation Series on public safety and health topics.
 - Provide an additional venue for Town staff to educate residents about topics such as fire safety, water safety, monsoon safety, and emergency preparedness.
 - Partner with other agencies to bring in expert speakers on other important topics such as suicide prevention, domestic violence, mental health and opioid awareness.
 - Costs associated with each one hour event are estimated to be approximately \$500 in staff time.
 Holding six events per year would be \$3,000 in staff costs for the year.
