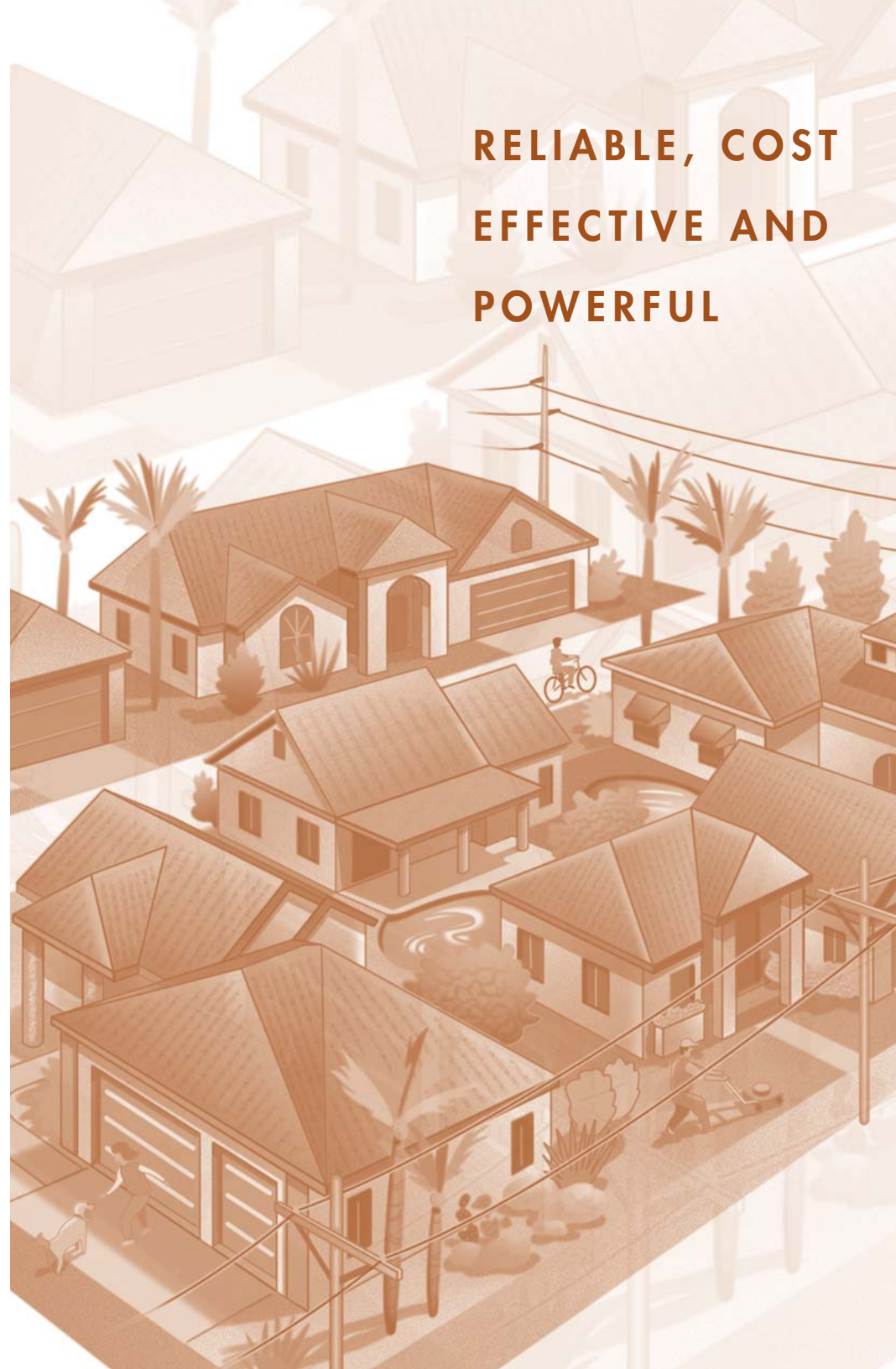

# SRP IS PLANNING FOR QUEEN CREEK'S ELECTRIC SYSTEM NEEDS

SRP, a major provider of electricity to the Valley, is exploring and considering ways to improve power reliability in the Queen Creek area. Like many areas of the SRP service territory, Queen Creek is planning for commercial and residential growth. We also have to keep up with increased usage in Queen Creek. Even with energy-efficient appliances, the popularity and the proliferation of home electronics, such as computers and entertainment equipment has the average residence using about 10 percent more electricity than a decade ago.

The increased use and need for electricity in Queen Creek is creating a strain on the existing power distribution

system. Our planners forecast new facilities, including substations and 69,000-volt (69kV) powerlines, will be needed to support the growing electrical demand and provide balance to the electrical system, particularly when economic growth resumes.

In the coming weeks, SRP will be conducting a collaborative public process to determine the most cost-effective and beneficial way to enhance the 69kV delivery system in Queen Creek. This means we will be talking to individual residents as well as holding open houses to share information and obtain feedback from the community. We want to ensure all important issues unique to your community are considered.
