Attorney Sam Coffman, representing the Town, provided a brief review of the litigation timeline that began in May 2015 against the Town and individuals John Kross, Gail Barney and Wayne Balmer. The Town was dismissed as a defendant in 2017 and the individuals were dismissed in March 2018, and at same time confirmed the Town was dismissed. The Town refiled for fee award. Mr. Coffman explained the settlement Agreement and Release stipulates that that VIP will not appeal the case any further and the Town will not seek award of fees and the case will be closed.
