Town of Queen Creek Public Lake Regulations

- 1. All Arizona Game and Fish <u>Community Fishing Program rules and regulations</u> must be followed, including licensing requirements and daily bag limits.
- 2. The lake is open daily during regular park hours.
- 3. All fishing must be done from the lake shore.
- 4. Fish may only be taken by pole or line.
- 5. Cleaning fish and discarding fish remains in a Town lake or within the confines of a Town park or facility is prohibited.
- 6. Dispose of all fishing line, bait, and hooks in proper trash receptacles located around the lake and park.
- 7. Do not feed any wildlife or leave any kind of food unattended in Town parks.
- 8. Do not release domestic or wild animals into a Town lake.
- 9. Do not harm or capture waterfowl or other wildlife.
- 10. Do not throw or discard any object or substance into the lake.
- 11. The following activities are prohibited at all times:
 - a. Swimming, bathing, and wading,
 - b. Voluntarily entering the water from the shoreline,
 - c. Jumping or diving from any structures on or around the lake,
 - d. Pet swimming,
 - e. Operating or using any boat, raft, or other watercraft, including canoes and kayaks,
 - f. Operating or using any raft, inner-tube, inflatable mattress, catamaran, sailboat, or any inflatable craft,
 - g. Operating or using any remote controlled boat or watercraft.
- 12. The Recreation Superintendent, or designee, shall interpret these regulations and may act in any case not specifically covered herein.
