RESOLUTION 1232-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF QUEEN CREEK, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON AUGUST 28, 2018; AND ORDERING THE RECORDING.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Queen Creek, Maricopa County, Arizona did cause to be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town at a Primary Election called and held in and for the Town on the 28th day of August 2018 for the election of a Mayor and three (3) four year Council Members and the proposition for extending the Alternative Expenditure Limitation/Home Rule ; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Queen Creek, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1: Arizona Revised Statutes 9-821.01 sets forth the procedure for calculating the majority of votes cast at a primary election in order for a candidate to win at the primary by adding all of the votes cast for all candidates for the office, dividing by the number of seats to be filled and then dividing the result of the calculation by two and rounding to the highest whole number.

SECTION 2: That the total number of ballots cast at said Primary Election, as shown by the "Precinct Canvass" (Exhibit A) was 7565.

SECTION 3: That the number of rejected ballots as shown on Exhibit B was 30.

SECTION 4: That the votes cast for Mayor were as follows:

<u>Name</u>	<u>Votes</u>
Gail Barney	6388

SECTION 5: That the calculation for determining the majority of vote for Council Member is as follows:

Total Votes:	15275
Divided by 3 =	5091.67
Divided by 2 =	2546 (rounded to next whole #)

Total number of votes needed to win at the Primary is 2546 or more.

SECTION 5: That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record that four (4) candidates did receive more than one-half of the total number of valid votes cast and that four (4) candidates did receive the greatest number of votes of the electors of the Town voting at said election and are hereby issued a Certificate of Election:

Mayor – 4 year term:	Gail Barney
Council Member – 4 year term:	Dawn Oliphant Emilena Turley Julia Wheatley

SECTION 6: That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record that the voters of the Town approved Proposition 407/424 Alternative Expenditure Limitation/Home Rule as follows:

YES: 5273
NO: 1658

SECTION 7: That all orders or resolutions in conflict be and the same are, to the extent such conflict are hereby repealed, and this resolution is in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
