






Challenge


How soon could the team open up Meridian Road from Combs to north of the Queen Creek Wash?

Obstacles


Queen Creek Wash - Army Core of Engineers

10 Year Transportation Infrastructure Improvement Plan

















Project Features

- Full Box Culvert
- Interim roadway (one lane each direction) from Combs to just north of the QC Wash
- Temporary traffic signals



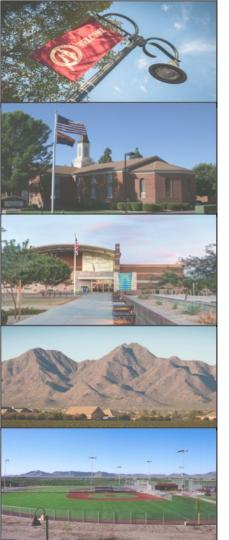


Costs


- \$4.43 million
 - \$3.93 million permanent infrastructure
 - \$380K interim improvements
 - \$120k temp traffic signals (reusable)

 Project is 50/50 Partnership with Pinal County






Benefit - Emergency Response Times







Benefit - Alternative route during construction of Rittenhouse Road project








Benefit – Another North/South Roadway
