BCGEV Profile

- Serve 10,500 registered members and an additional 25,000 young people ages 5 to 18 annually
- 11 Clubhouses are located in 9 communities within neighborhoods with a significant need for safe and positive "out of school time" programs:
 - Apache JunctionMesaChandlerStevenson (East Mesa)Gila River SacatonNorth TempeGila River Komatke (Laveen)TempeGilbertGuadalupeQueen Creek
- Supported by 150 full and part time staff and 2000 volunteers
- Focus on "those in need"
 - **75%** of members from minority races/ethnicities
 - **66%** of members qualify for free or reduced lunch
 - **40%** of members are from single family households






Club Vision
