


Zoning **Equivalency Map**

R1-5/PAD - Residential


PRC/PAD - Recreation/Conservation MDR/PAD - Residential



ANNEXATION TIMELINE

Encanterra Annexation Timeline		
Steps	Date	Tasks
1	July 19, 2018	Request property owner and assessed valuation information from Pinal County Assessor and Arizona Department of Revenue.
2	Nov. 7, 2018	Record blank petition, map, and legal description with Pinal County Assessor. The 30-day waiting period begins.
3	Nov. 20, 2018	Post the Property for the Public Hearing.
4	Nov. 17, 2018	Publish notice of Public Hearing in the newspaper.
5	Nov. 20, 2018	Mail notice of public hearing to property owners and the Chairman of the Pinal County Board of Supervisors.
6	Dec. 5, 2018	Public Hearing at the Town Council Meeting to discuss the annexation proposal and receive public comments.
7	Dec. 7, 2018	30-day waiting period ends. The applicant can begin collecting signatures.
8	Oct. 8, 2019	Record signed Petitions.
9	Oct. 16, 2019	Discussion and possible action to adopt Ordinance at the Town Council Meeting.
10	Nov. 19, 2019, Tuesday 8:00 am	Annexation Effective. Record Ordinance.
