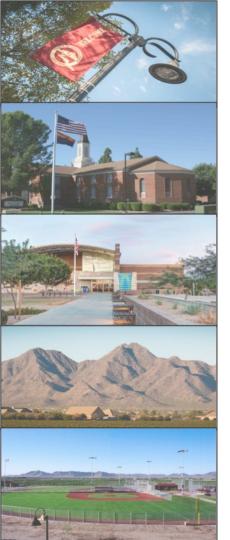


THE ISSUE




Traffic in and around Queen Creek continues to be a major challenge

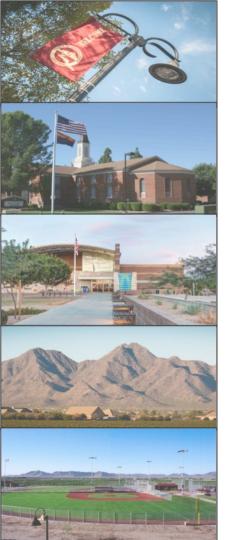
- Developer required ½ street improvements

- Public and Private utility installations




Annually over 800 Traffic Control plans are approved by the Town






Perfect Grid System




Gilbert/Chandler Grid System South the 202





The Challenge with Queen Creek's Grid System










Queen Creek Transportation Projects – Completed 2017-2020



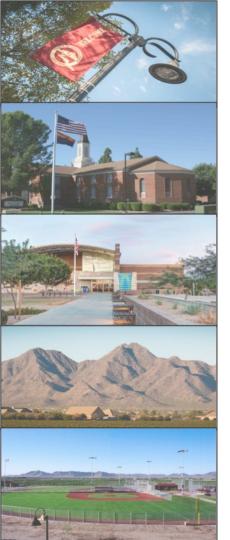

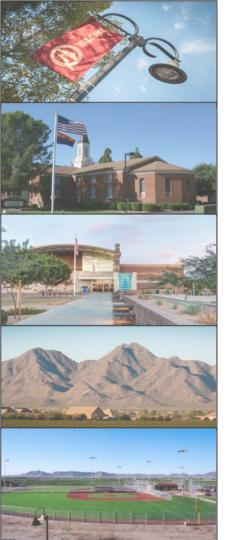
- Mobility
