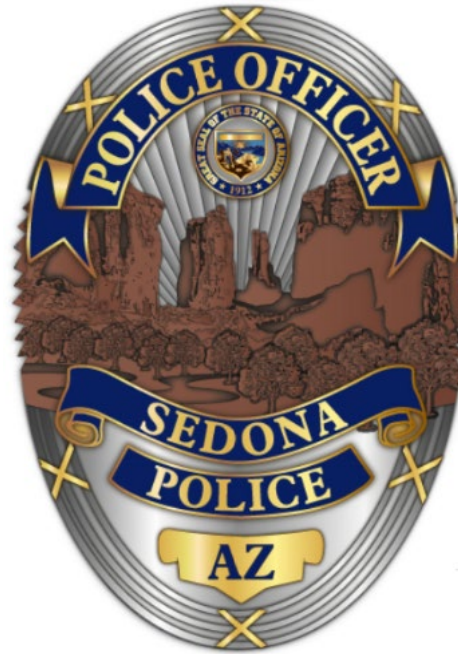

Existing badge designs (final look)

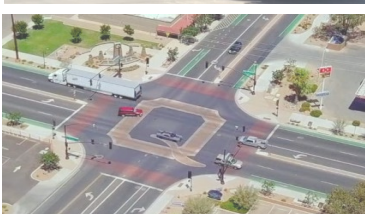

and creek)



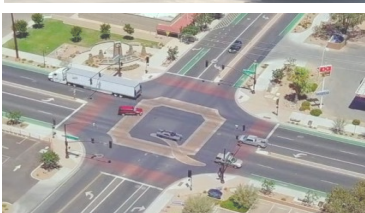

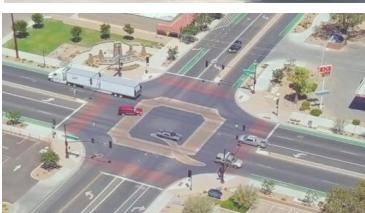
## Concept #3:

## **Option 2 (Changes requested; proceed after changes are completed):**

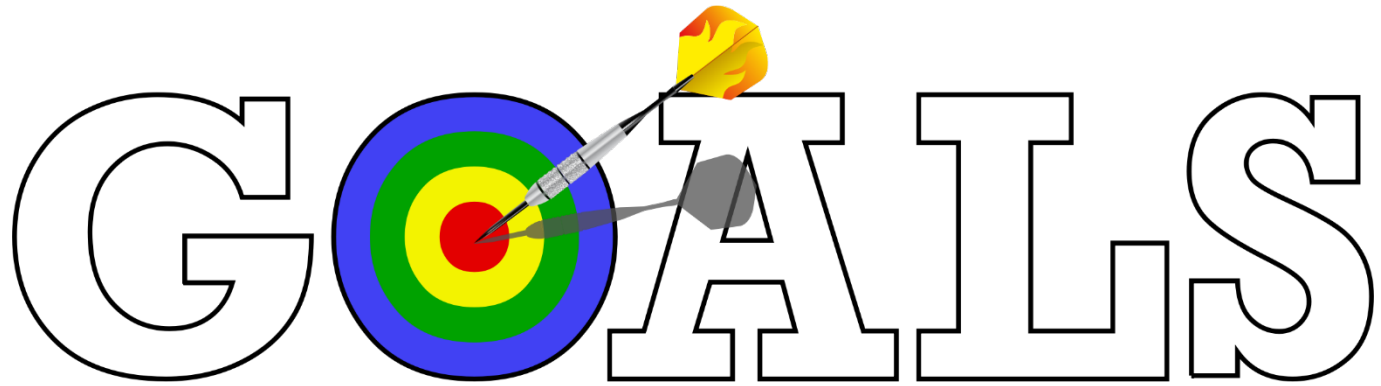
- Council provides additional feedback/changes on the presented patch and badges designs
