Background

- Impact and Capacity Fees are One-Time
 Fees Paid by New Development to Mitigate
 the Cost of New Infrastructure Installed to
 Maintain the Adopted Service Levels
 - Impact Fees (6): Police, Fire, Transportation, Parks, Library, and Town Facilities
 - Capacity Fees (2): Water and Wastewater
 - Service Areas are Larger than the Town Boundary











Background (continued)

- Fee Amounts
 - State Law Provides Guidance RE. Fee Calculations
 - Effective Date of Last Fee Update
 - Impact Fees: February 10, 2020
 - Capacity Fees: July 1, 2019
 - Example: Single-Family House Fee
 - Can be one of three amounts based upon when first permit in subdivision was paid
 - \$10,635
 - \$12,077
 - \$12,648











Background (concluded)

Reporting

- Impact Fees: Annual Report Required by State Law
- Capacity Fees: Annual Report Required by Town Council Financial Policy
- Town Council Acceptance of Both Reports: Required per Town Council Financial Policy to Improve Communication to the Public and the Development Community











FY 19-20 Activity

Very High Activity Levels

Impact Fees:	
Single-Family Residential Units	1,735
Multi-Family Units	50
Non-Residential Square Feet	~250K
Capacity Fees:	
Water Fees Assessed	1,807
Wastewater Fees Assessed	1,549
