WHEREAS, these statistics demonstrate the importance of work zone safety and spreading the message that everyone plays a role - motorists can safely navigate work zones so they and roadway workers make it safely home to their families each day; and

WHEREAS, Go Orange Day will be honored on Wednesday, April 28, a day when individuals are encouraged to wear orange as a visual reminder to others of work zones; and


WHEREAS, everyone deserves to get home safely – Drive safe. Work safe. Save lives.


