3. A copy of this application and the accepted TCP is to be kept on-site **AT ALL TIMES** when operations are occurring as apart of an accepted TCP.
4. A signed copy of the encroachment permit is to accompany the application and proposed Traffic Control Plans.
5. Submit the application, permit copy, and proposed Traffic Control Plan as a single combined PDF file.
