# **QC Property Tax History**

- 2007 Voter Approved Primary Property Tax
  - Dedicated for Public Safety
  - Created to Provide a Stable Revenue
    Source to Pay for Public Safety
  - "Not to Exceed to \$1.95 Levy"
- QC Does Not Have a Secondary Property Tax (Voter Approved for Capital)





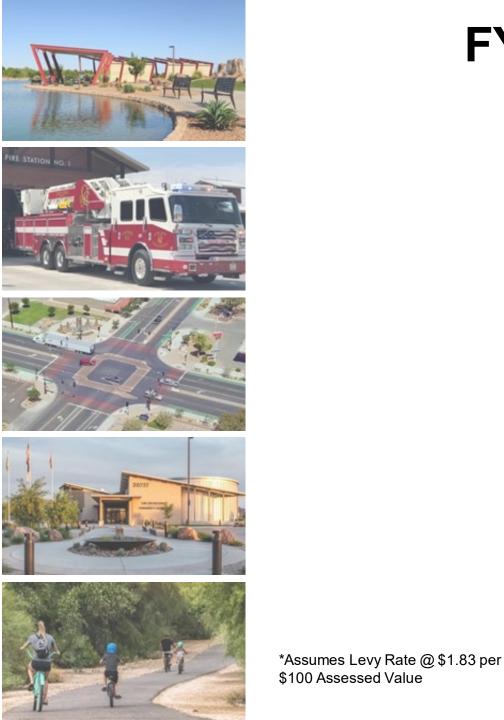




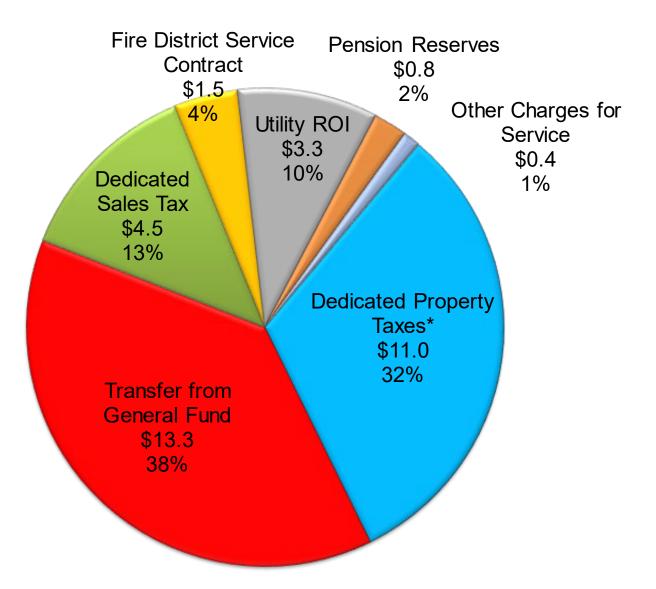


# **EMS Fund Overview**

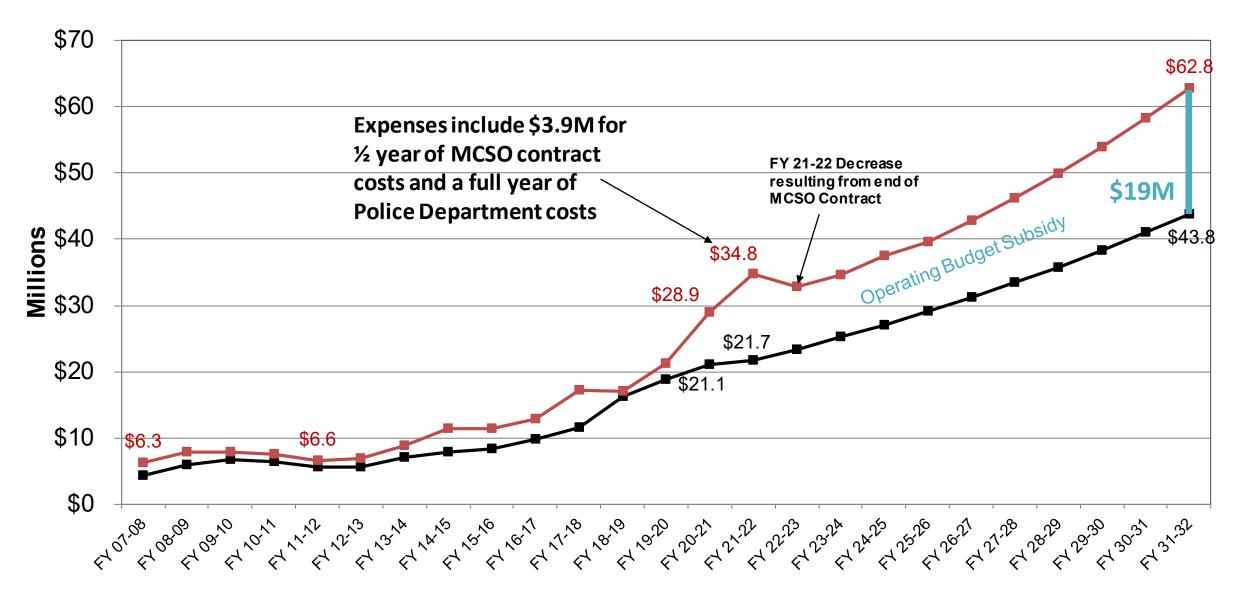
- The FY 2021-22 Budget Forecast Expenses
  are \$34.8M
  - Fire: \$15.7M
  - Police: \$15.2M
  - MCSO Contract: \$3.9M
- Property Tax is The Largest Dedicated Funding Source at \$11.0M (Covers 32% of Expenses)
- Over the Next 5 Years, Annual Costs are Expected to Increase by ~\$8M for Additional Fire and Police Staffing

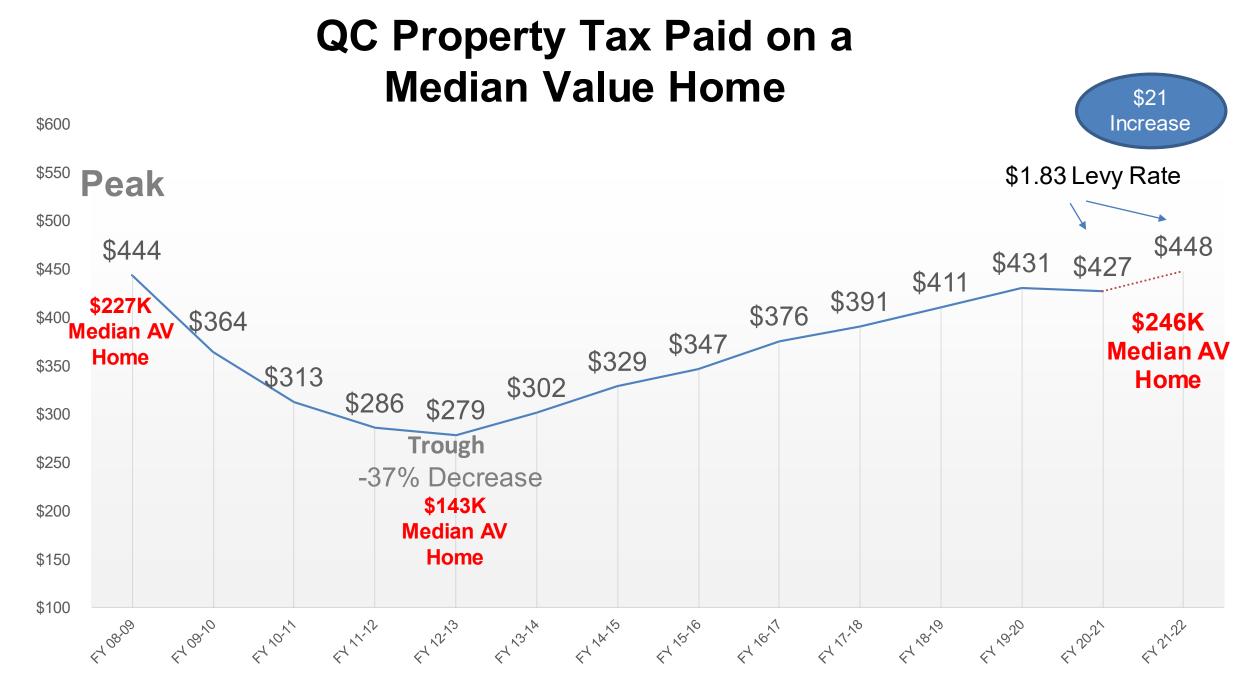




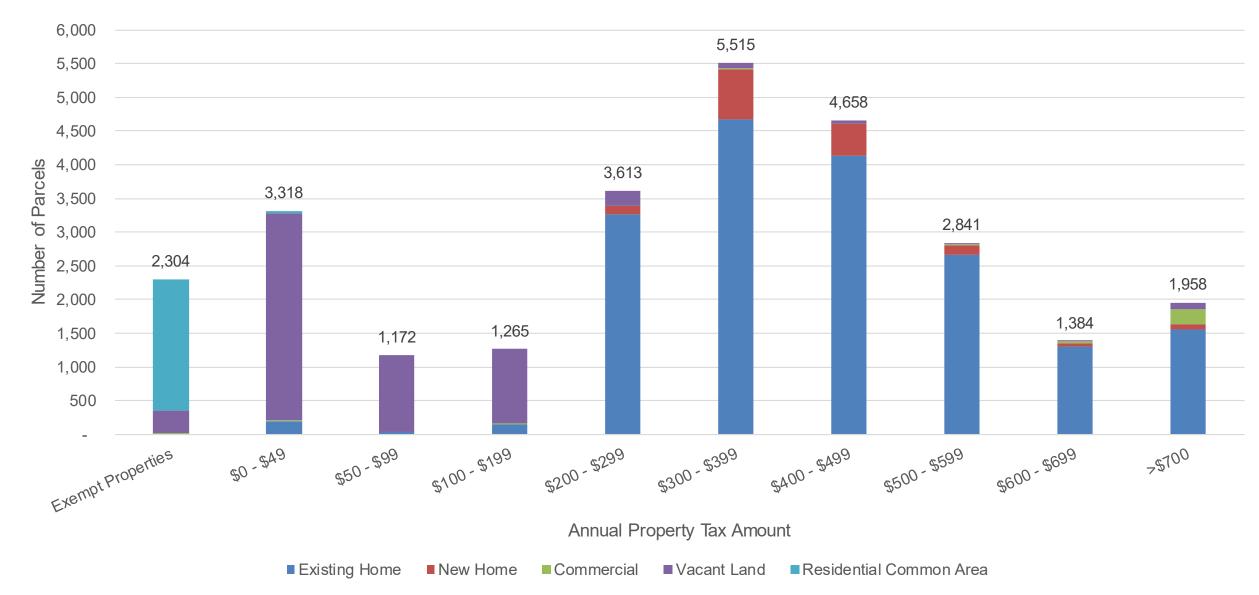


# Individual Parcel Impact

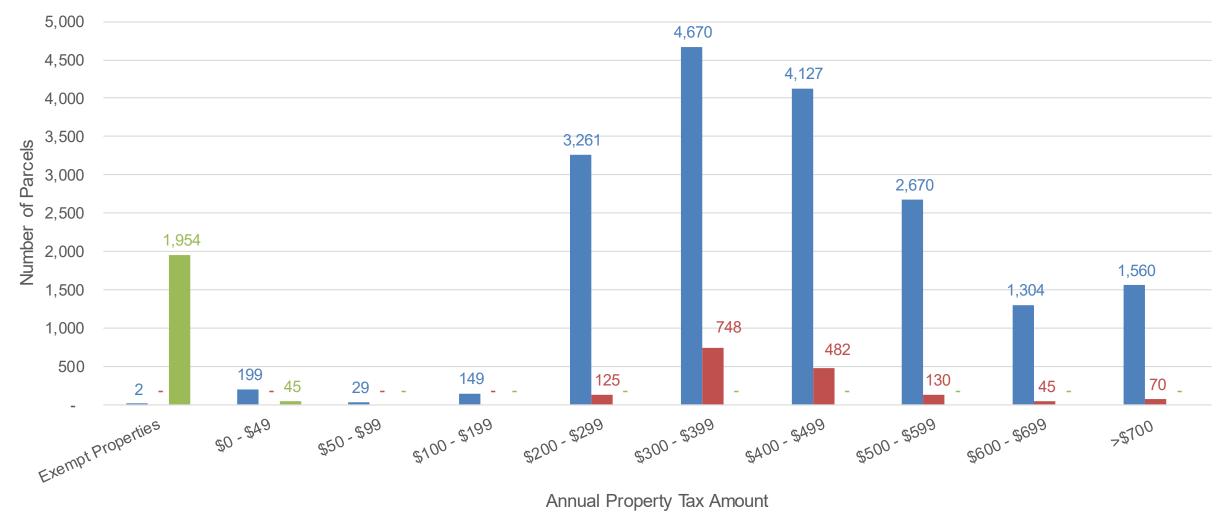
- About 28K Parcels

  - The Individual Parcel Appreciation Increase is Limited by State Statute to 5% (Assuming Land Use Remains the Same)



#### Property Taxes: All Property Types (28K Parcels)

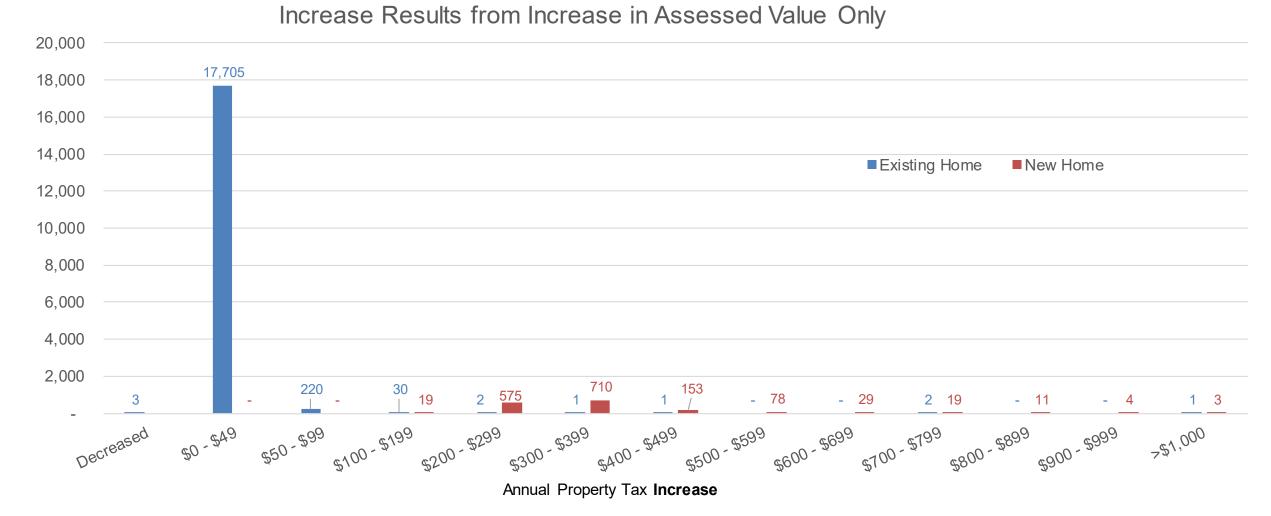


#### **Property Taxes: Homes Only**

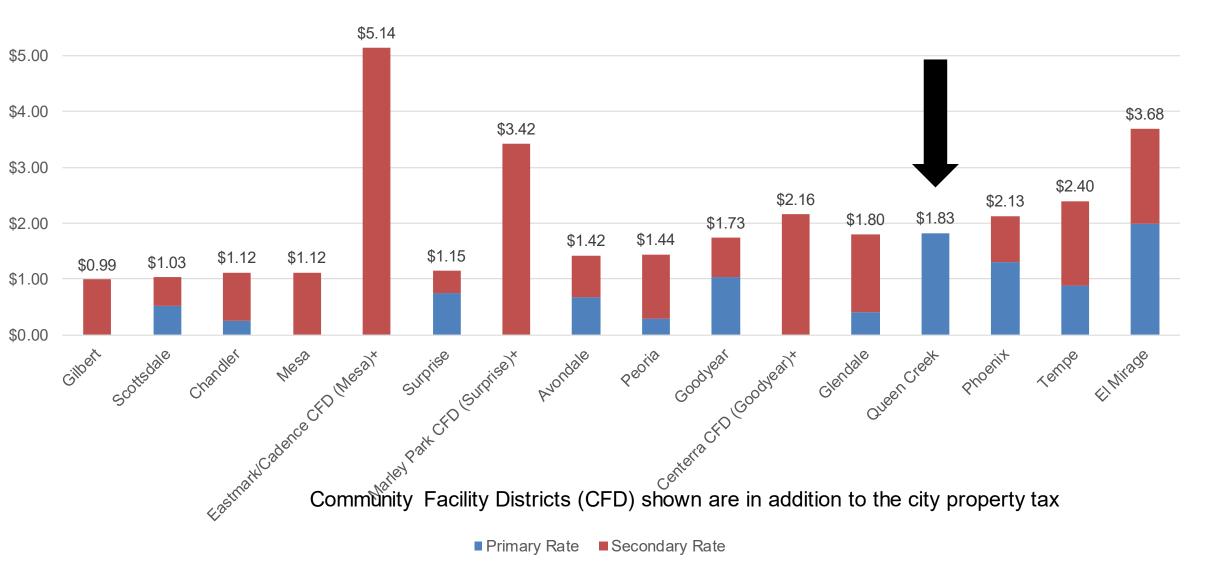


Existing Home New Home Residential Common Area

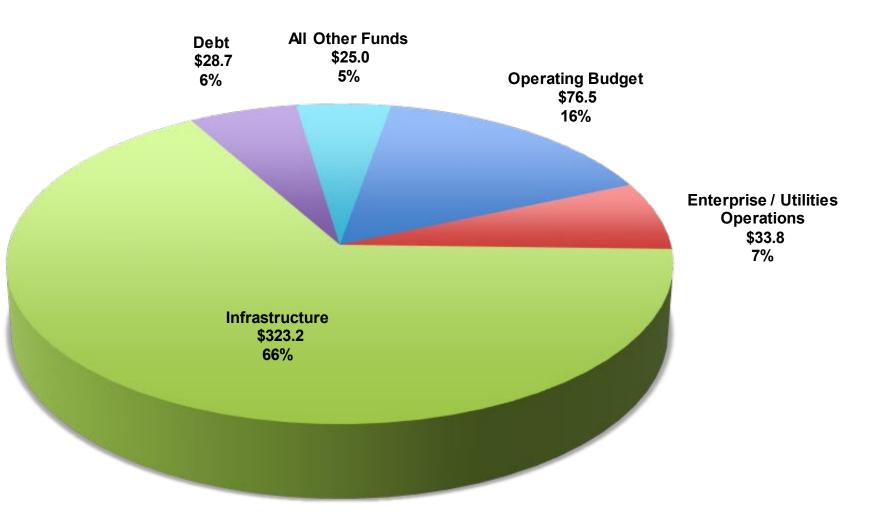








#### FY 21-22 FINAL BUDGET \$487.2M





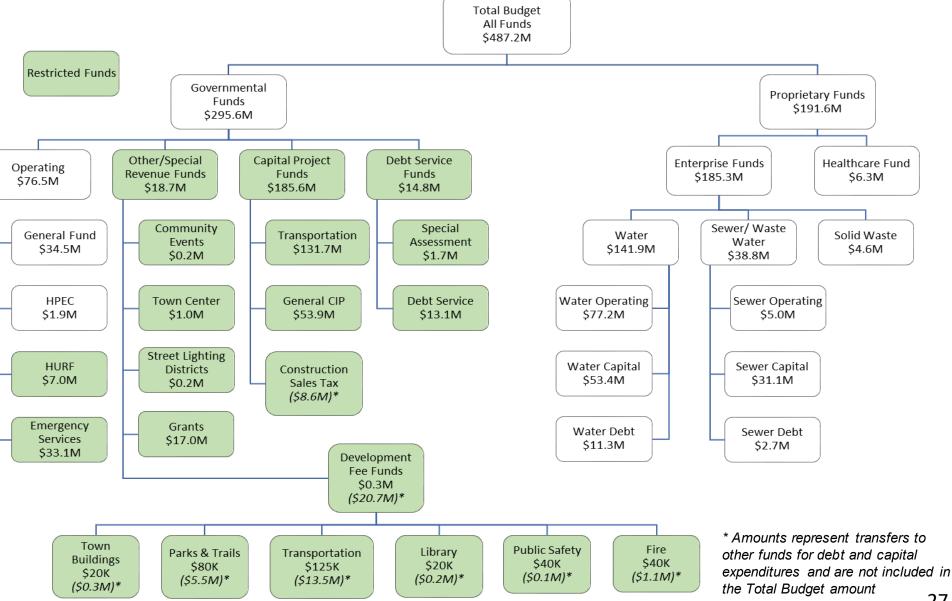






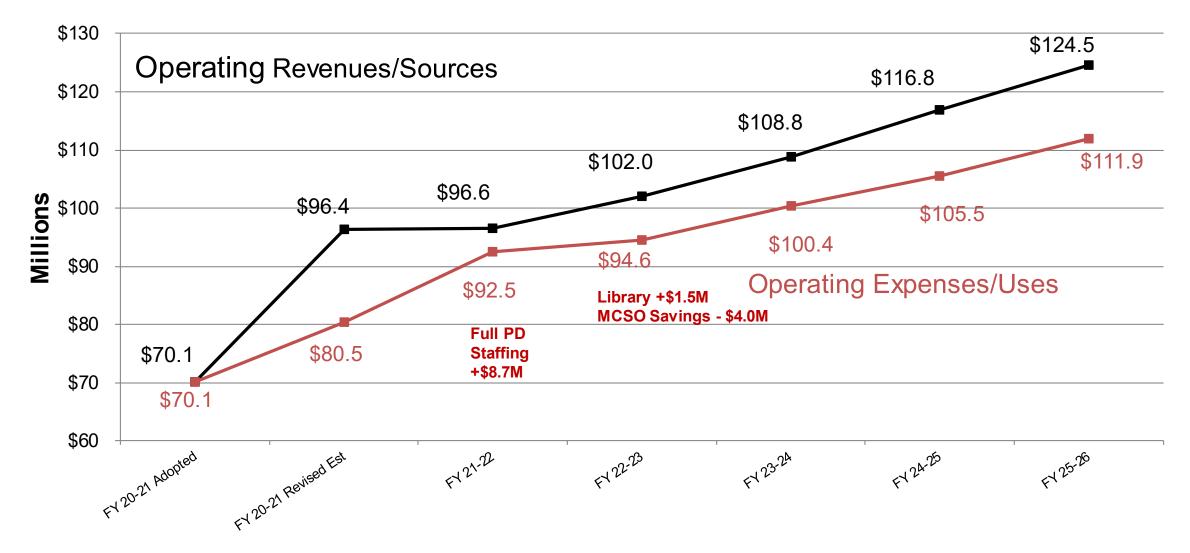


#### BUDGET/FUND STRUCTURE : \$487.2M
