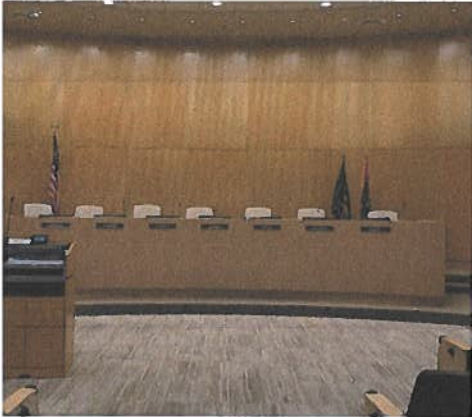

WHEREAS, the ABCDs of water safety are simple steps to help protect children around water and to avoid the tragedy of the unnecessary loss of life; and

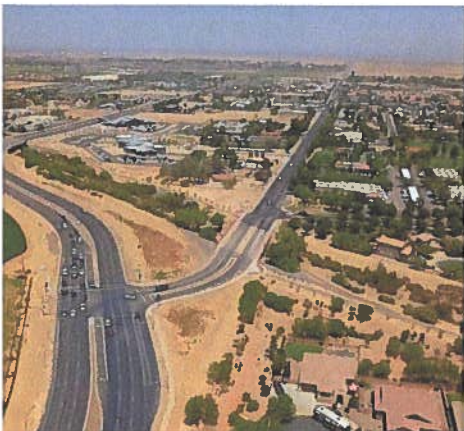
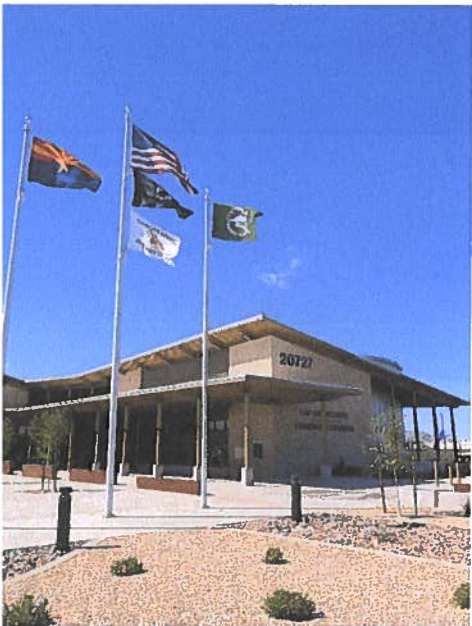
