- Set public hearing date of December 15, 2021












Credit Card & Debit Card Transaction Fees – Development Services



(a) Switched payment processors and offered ACH payment option











Recommended Service Fee

- A fee charged on all credit card and debit card transactions for Development Services <u>Transactions only</u>
 - Does <u>NOT</u> apply to any other transactions including
 - Water/Sewer/Trash Utility Bills
 - Recreation Classes
 - Business Licenses
 - HPEC Rentals and Sales
- Rate: 2.4%
 - Rate established by processor based on our history / volume
 - Non-refundable
- Estimated Savings: \$435K











Customer Options to Avoid the Service Fee

- 1. Use ACH / Electronic Check
- 2. Use a Trust Account (Limited Availability)
 - Lump sum deposited with the Town
 - Funds drawn down and applied to permits as needed
 - Only for customers with high-volume high-dollar transactions (e.g., home builders)

Motion to approve Ordinance No. 779-21 adopting a service fee on credit card and debit card payments made through the Development Services Department.
