WHEREAS, strong commitments to supporting families and building resilience in youth help communities thrive; and

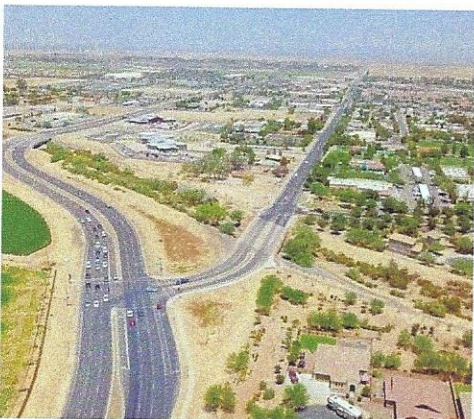
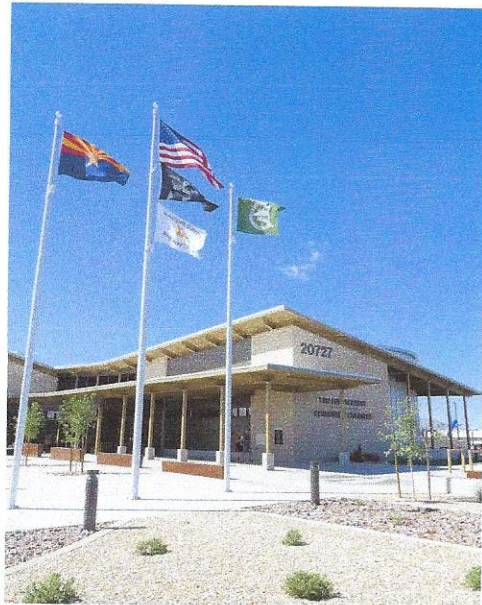
WHEREAS, everyone can be involved in child abuse prevention and supporting local agencies and activities that provide opportunities and supports to families in need.


