Background

- The Town Collects 6 Impact Fees and 2 Capacity Fees
- One-Time Fees to Pay for the Growth Portion of New Infrastructure Built to Maintain Existing Service Levels
 - 1. Water
 - 2. Wastewater
 - 3. Transportation
 - 4. Police
 - 5. Fire
 - 6. Parks
 - 7. Library
 - 8. Town Facilities











Fee Purpose and Amounts

- Collected to Pay the Growth Portion of Debt Costs Issued to Construct Buildings Several Years Ago
- Schedule of Fee Amount Below

PERMIT TYPE	FACILITY	LIBRARY
Single-Family Home	\$76	\$167
Multi-Family Unit	\$54	\$120
Commercial / Retail	\$18 per 1K Square Foot	\$39 per 1K Square Foot
Office	\$26 per 1K Square Foot	\$57 per 1K Square Foot
Industrial	\$26 per 1K Square Foot	\$58 per 1K Square Foot



Fees Received Have Exceeded Projections Over the Last 4 Years (FY17-18 to FY 20-21)







	Projected per Study	Actual	Variance	Variance %
Facility Fees	\$0.5M	\$2.1M	\$1.6M	354%
Library Fees	\$1M	\$3.1M	\$2.1M	206%











Fees Received Over the Last 4 Years Were Greater Than the 10-Year Projection

(FY17-18 to FY 20-21)

	10- Year Projected			Variance
	per Study	Actual	Variance	%
Facility Fees	\$1.1M	\$2.1M	\$1.0M	91%
Library Fees	\$2.3M	\$3.1M	\$0.8M	35%











Financial Analysis

- Fees No Longer Need to be Collected
- Cash Balances are Effectively Enough to Defease the Remaining Debt Payments
 - Facility: \$2.7M
 - Library: \$2.2M
- Defeasance Structure Still Needs to be Finalized and Will Require Town Council Action
 - Debt Cannot be Paid Off Today
 - Expected Defeasance Recommendation: August 2022

Approve Resolution 1460-22 Eliminating the Library Facility Development Impact Fee and Declaring an Emergency to Accelerate the Effective Date to May 23, 2022

(6 Affirmative Votes Required for the Emergency Provision)
