
PROCLAMATION




WHEREAS, due to its desert location, the Town of Queen Creek frequently experiences thunderstorm-generated wind, dust, electrical storms and dangerous flash floods during the summer monsoon, all of which pose a considerable threat to the community; and

WHEREAS, lives are put at risk and substantial property damage is caused by rapidly developing severe thunderstorms, flash floods and lightning strikes; and

WHEREAS, each year public safety personnel put their lives at risk to rescue citizens who become victims of severe thunderstorms, flash floods and lightning strikes; and



WHEREAS, the Town of Queen Creek joins the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Weather Service, along with local law enforcement agencies, and fire departments in recognizing the need to educate all citizens on how to properly respond when severe thunderstorms and flash floods strike our town.





In the Town of Queen Creek, and urge all residents to review severe weather safety and disaster planning information, and to use those lifesaving recommendations to protect themselves and their families from the hazards that accompany the summer monsoon season.
