**WHEREAS**, Queen Creek, AZ supports our local businesses that create jobs, boost our local economy, and preserve our communities; and


**WHEREAS**, advocacy groups, as well as public and private organizations across the country have endorsed the Saturday after Thanksgiving as Small Business Saturday.


