**WHEREAS**, there is no test or screening exam that can detect ovarian cancer in its early stages; and


**WHEREAS**, citizens are encouraged to learn more about the subtle signs, symptoms, and current treatment options available to women to identify and overcome this disease; and


**WHEREAS**, Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month is a time to remember and honor those who fought hard but lost their battle to ovarian cancer;
