







History

- Only questions that were received were out of the Town limits




Changes


- Billing change

- New Construction
 - Will change the fees structure for Fire Prevention Services
 - More focused on fire prevention equipment and systems than just square footage
 - Prior fees followed Rural/Metro fee structure
 - There will be a minimum fee associated with any plan review
 - To help off set cost of all employees that are used(Permit Techs etc.)
 - Permit fees comparable to other cities



- One time events/Special Hazards/Temporary Operations
 - Approximately 35 different events/hazards/operations
 - TOTAL = \$5,250
- Will go into effect February 1, 2011




 Emergency Medical Equipment and Standby Personnel

– Apparatus:


•	Battalion Vehicle	\$74.00/hr
•	Fire Engine	\$144.00/hr
•	Water Tender	\$113.00/hr
•	Brush Truck	\$ 76.00/hr

– Personnel:

 Battalion Chief 	\$26.03/hr
 Fire Captain/CEP 	\$23.86/hr
 Fire Engineer/CEP 	\$20.41/hr
 Fire Fighter/CFP 	\$18.49/hr



- Occupancy Inspection Program
 - High Hazard Occupancies yearly
 - \$100 per year X 64 = \$6,400
 - Medium Hazard Occupancies every two years
 - \$75 per year X 39.5 = \$2,962.5
 - Low Hazard Occupancies every three years
 - \$35 per year X 82.3 = \$2,881.6
 - TOTAL = \$12,244.10
 - Will go into effect July 1, 2011
