of Queen Creek



History

- HB 2246 now ARS 36-1601
- December 1, 2010 Consumer Fireworks now legal
- Ordinance 489-10 brought to Council 12-12-2010 Revisions Requested





Ordinance Revisions

- The use, discharge or ignition of permissible fireworks is limited to the third, fourth and fifth of July and December 31st and January first on private property with the owner's permission
- The use discharge or ignition of fireworks is prohibited in all public parks, public retentions and public facilities.



Permitting Requirements

- Tax Privilege License
- Certificate of insurance of 5,000,000 requiring the Town of Queen Creek named as additionally insured
- Town of Queen Creek Business License
- Copy of Certificate of Occupancy and Zoning Approval
- A letter from the owner of the property stating the approval of fireworks on such property.

Ordinance 489-10

- Approve ordinance as it now stands
- Ordinance will go into affect February 20th, 2011
