- Project of significance to both the community and the students
  - Town of Gilbert Mixed Use Development and Design Guidelines
  - Town of Goodyear employment corridor study
  - City of Tempe employment area study
- Project directed by Joochul Kim, PhD.
  - Thirteen eager graduate students
  - Kim Moyers and Mike McCauley to provide staff support, if needed



#### **Town Interest**

- Coordinate with our upcoming ULI Advisory Panel
- Support our upcoming zoning ordinance update
- Provide a definition and standards for a new "mixed use" zoning classification
- Provide additional design guidelines for our Town development design standards
- Further refinement of our Town Center Plan
- Possible inclusion in an update to the Town Redevelopment Area



# Scope of Work

- Review the Town Center Plan
  - Areas where further review and discussion might be helpful
- Review areas of recent change
  - Communiversity location
  - Ellsworth Road improvements
- Evaluate current issues
  - Entry concept
  - Development of an architectural and design theme for future Town Center Projects
  - Coordination between existing older developments and newer ones



# Scope of Work

- Focus on areas where further emphasis might be useful
  - Expansion of the Ellsworth Road design into other areas
- Develop new mixed use concepts for consideration
  - Definition and illustration of a conceptual mixed use project
  - Conversion of vacant commercial properties to mixed use projects
  - Development of an "activity spine" between Ellsworth and Ellsworth Loop roads with would benefit both areas



## **Project Goals**

- Development of concepts that could provide greater definition for the Plan
- Demonstrate how land use planning, urban design, landscaping, architecture and urban amenities can help create a unique Town Center
- Prepare documentation to demonstrate how the recommended concepts could be implemented
- Presentation of the proposed recommendations to the Town Council and Town Center Committee
