Service Levels for 2010

- 5 Patrol Beats
 - 25 Deputies
- 1 Community Police Deputy
- 2 School Resource Officers (SRO)
- 5 Sergeants
- 2 Detectives
- 1 Lieutenant
- 1 Captain

- 37 sworn deputies assigned to the Town



Incidents for 2010

- Incidents or “traffic” for the Town are divided into two categories.
 - Calls for Service (CFS) are citizen initiated calls
 - An individual dials 911 or the Non-Emergency number and requests service from MCSO.
 - Example: Theft, Welfare Check, or False Burglar Alarm
 - On View (OV) are deputy generated calls
 - A deputy observes an incident and takes action.
 - Example: Traffic Violation, Suspicious Person, or Follow-up/Report Writing



Incidents for 2010

- An error was discovered in the 2009 Total Incidents that were reported last year.
 - 2009 was originally reported at 13,444
 - 2,649 additional On View incidents were not captured
 - Over a year period, this equates to an additional 0.91 incidents per patrol beat (4 Beats), per shift (2)
 - 2009 Total Incidents are now 16,093



Incidents for 2010

- Total Incidents

- 2010: 15,882

- Calls For Service (CFS): 6,871 (43%)

- On-View (OV): 9,011 (57%)

- 2009 (revised): 16,093

- Calls For Service (CFS): 6,887 (43%)

- On-View (OV): 9,206 (57%)



Incidents for 2010

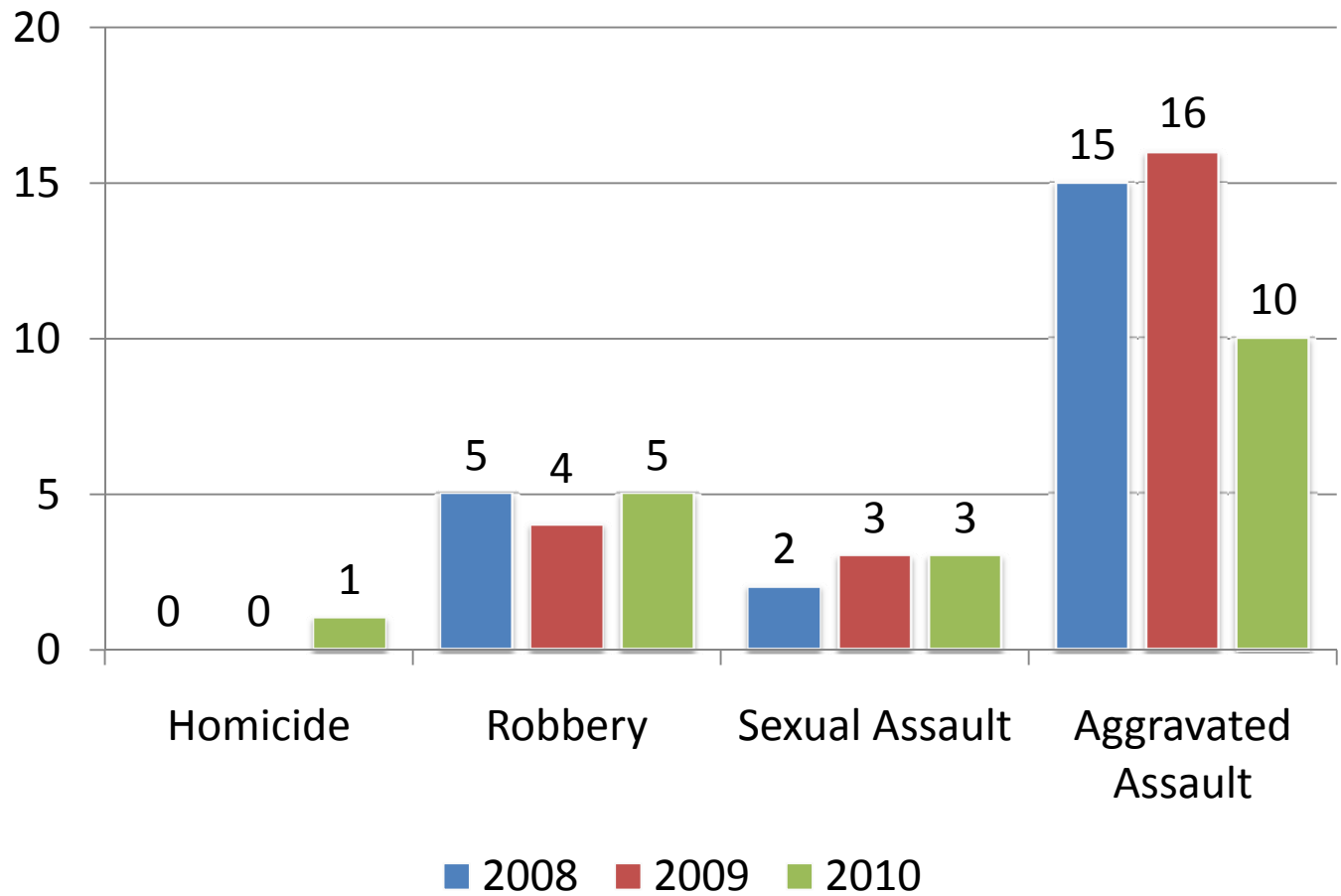
- A decrease of 211 incidents
- Percent Change from 2009 to 2010
 - Total Incidents: -1.3%
 - CFS: -0.2%
 - OV: -2.1%
 - Population: No Change



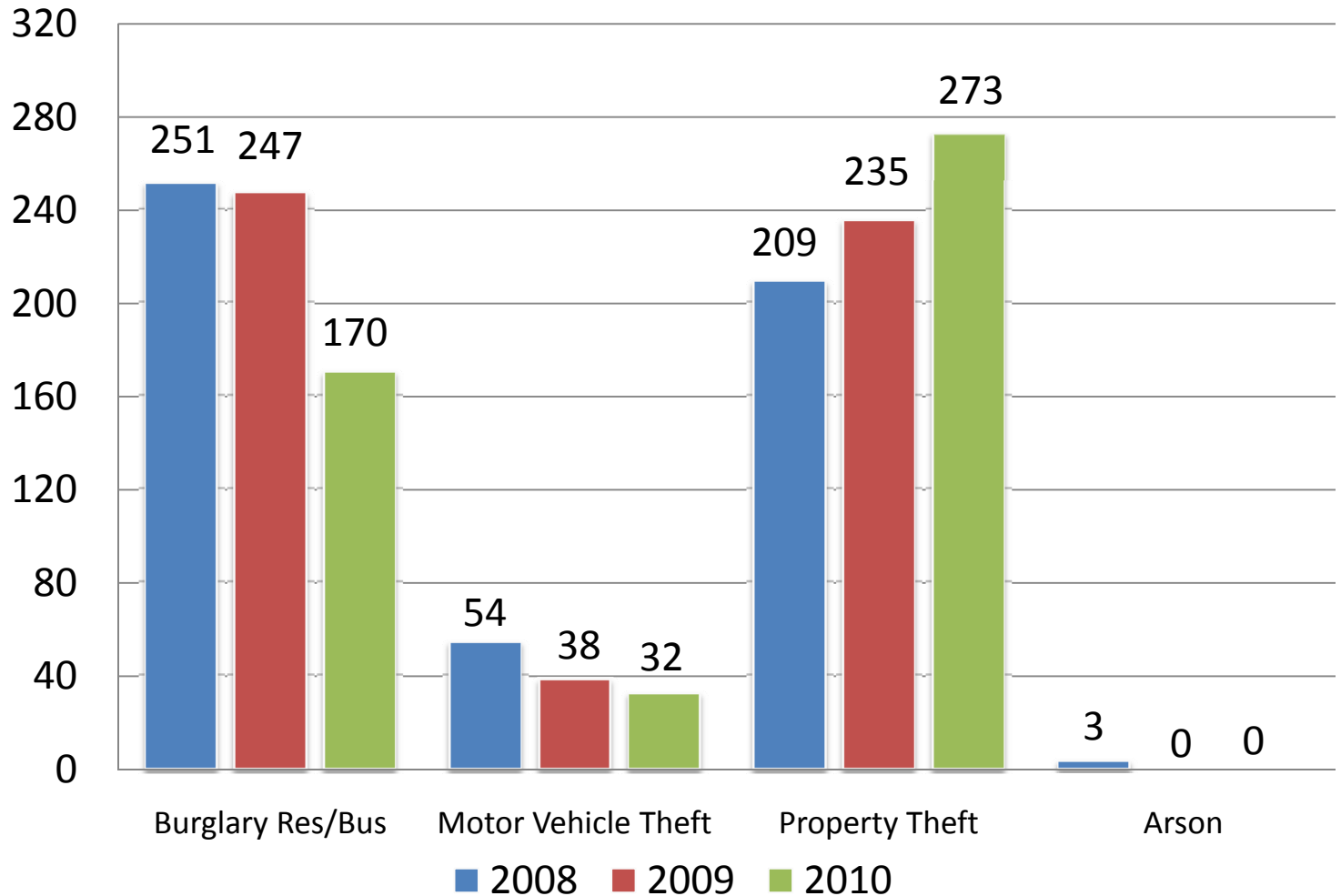
Uniform Crime Report

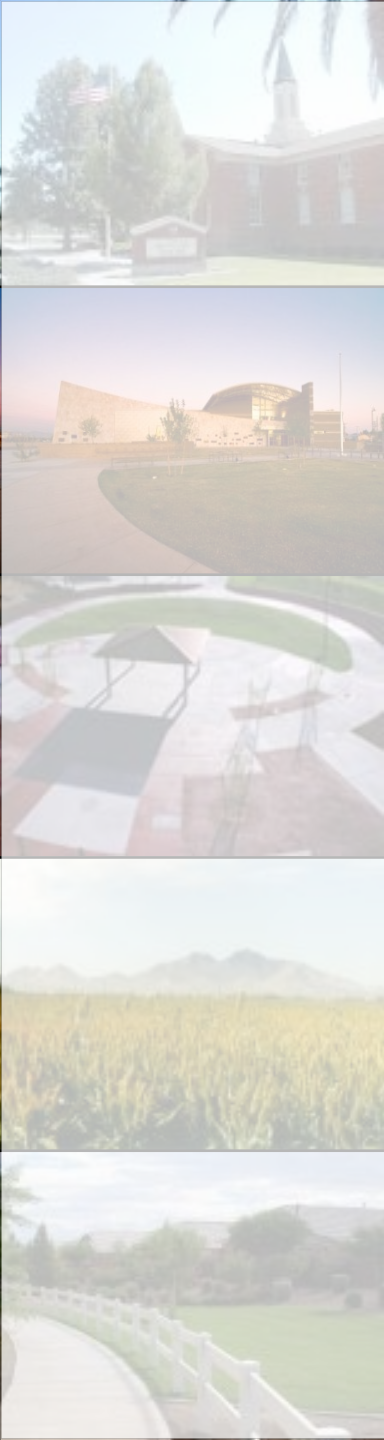
- The Uniform Crime Report (UCR)
 - A standardized system for the collection and reporting of crime statistics administered by the U.S. Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- Part I crimes consist of the following:
 - Crimes Against Persons:
 - Homicide, Sexual Assault, Robbery, Aggravated Assault
 - Crimes Against Property:
 - Burglary, Theft, Auto Theft and Arson

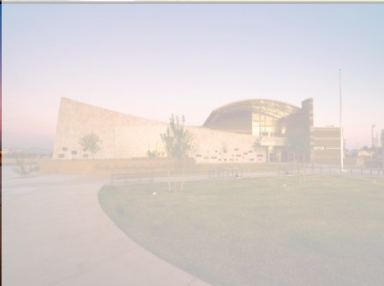

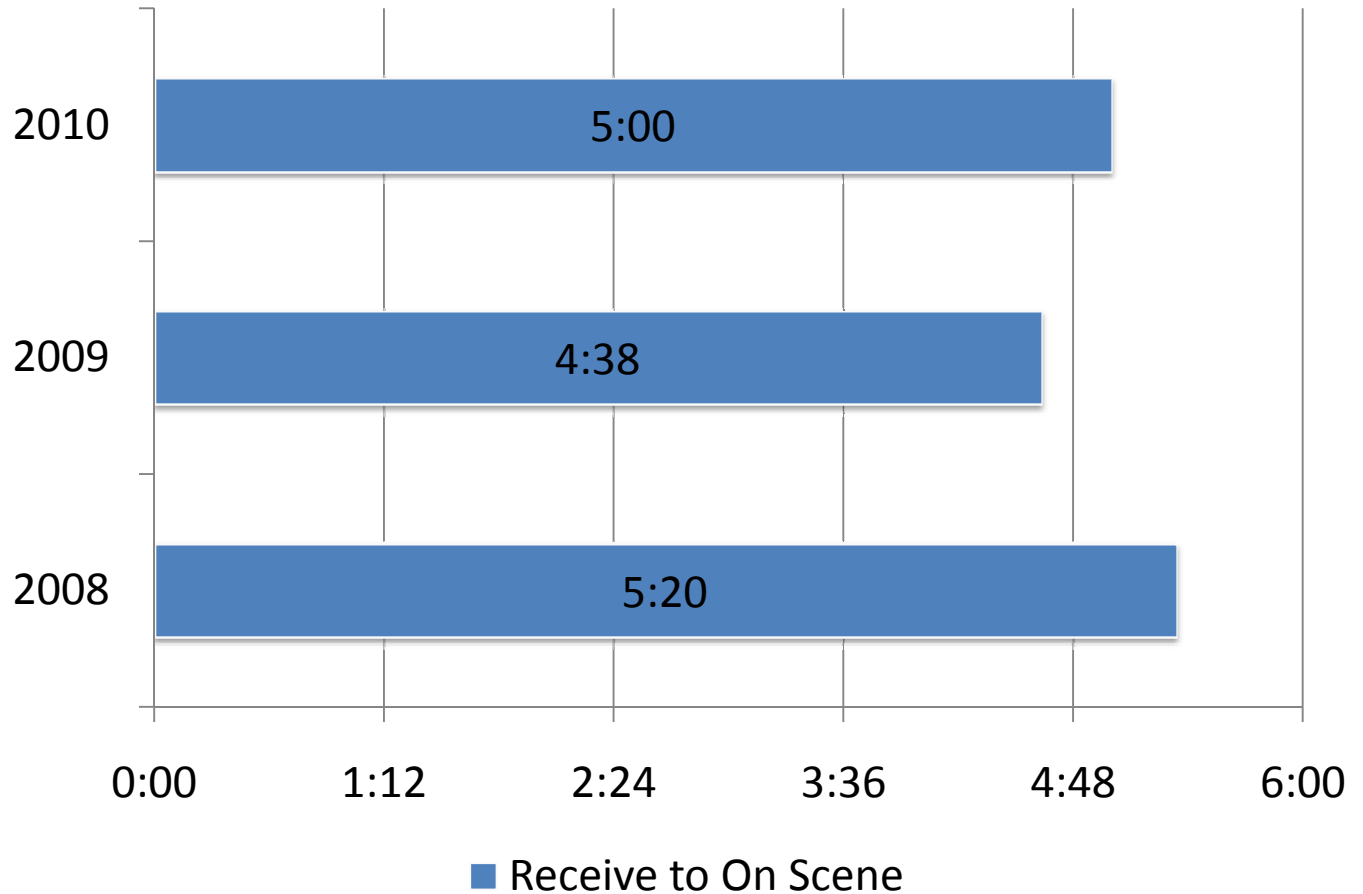

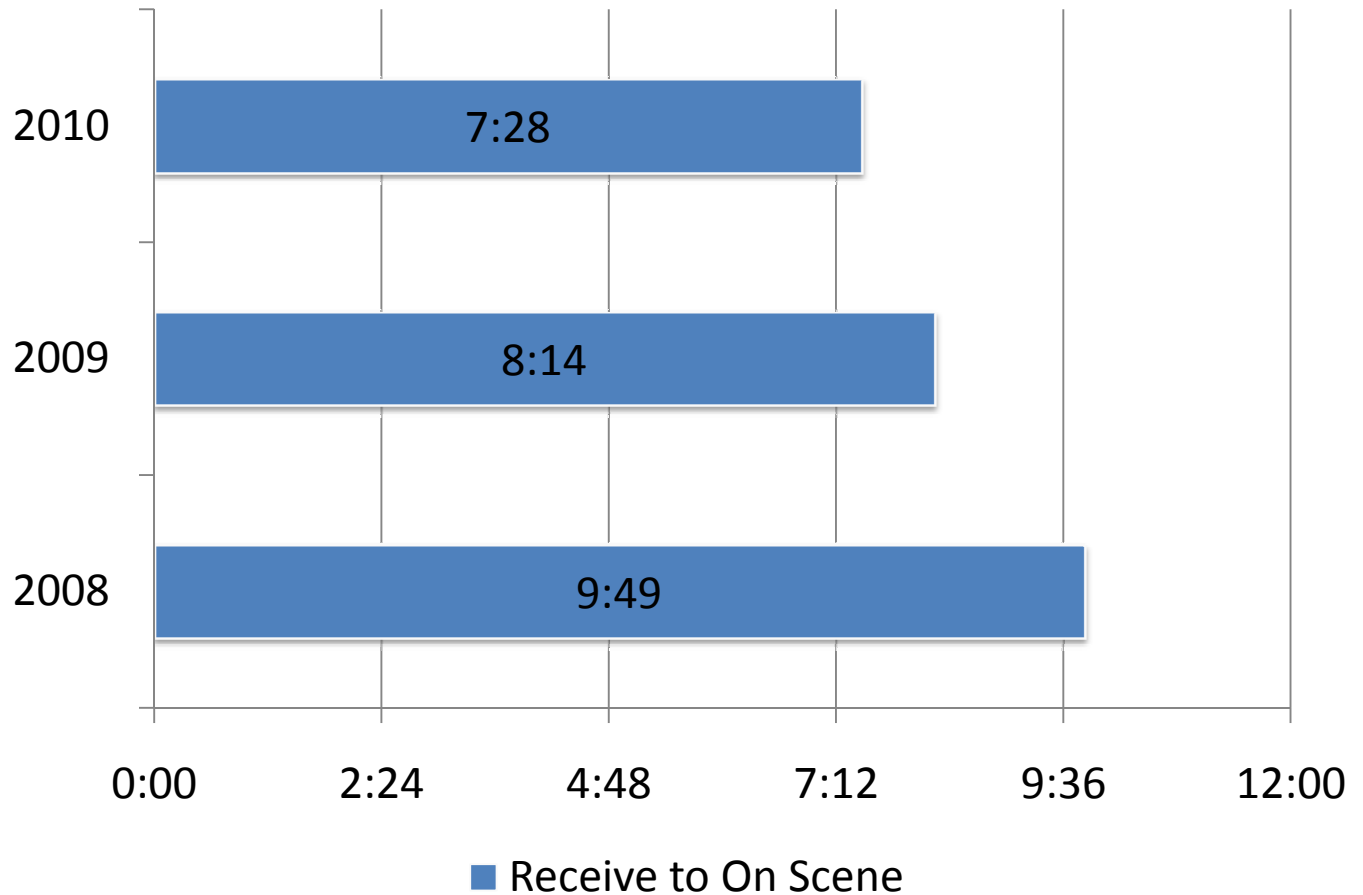
Response Time – Priority 1

(Crime in progress, life threatened, accident w/ injury)



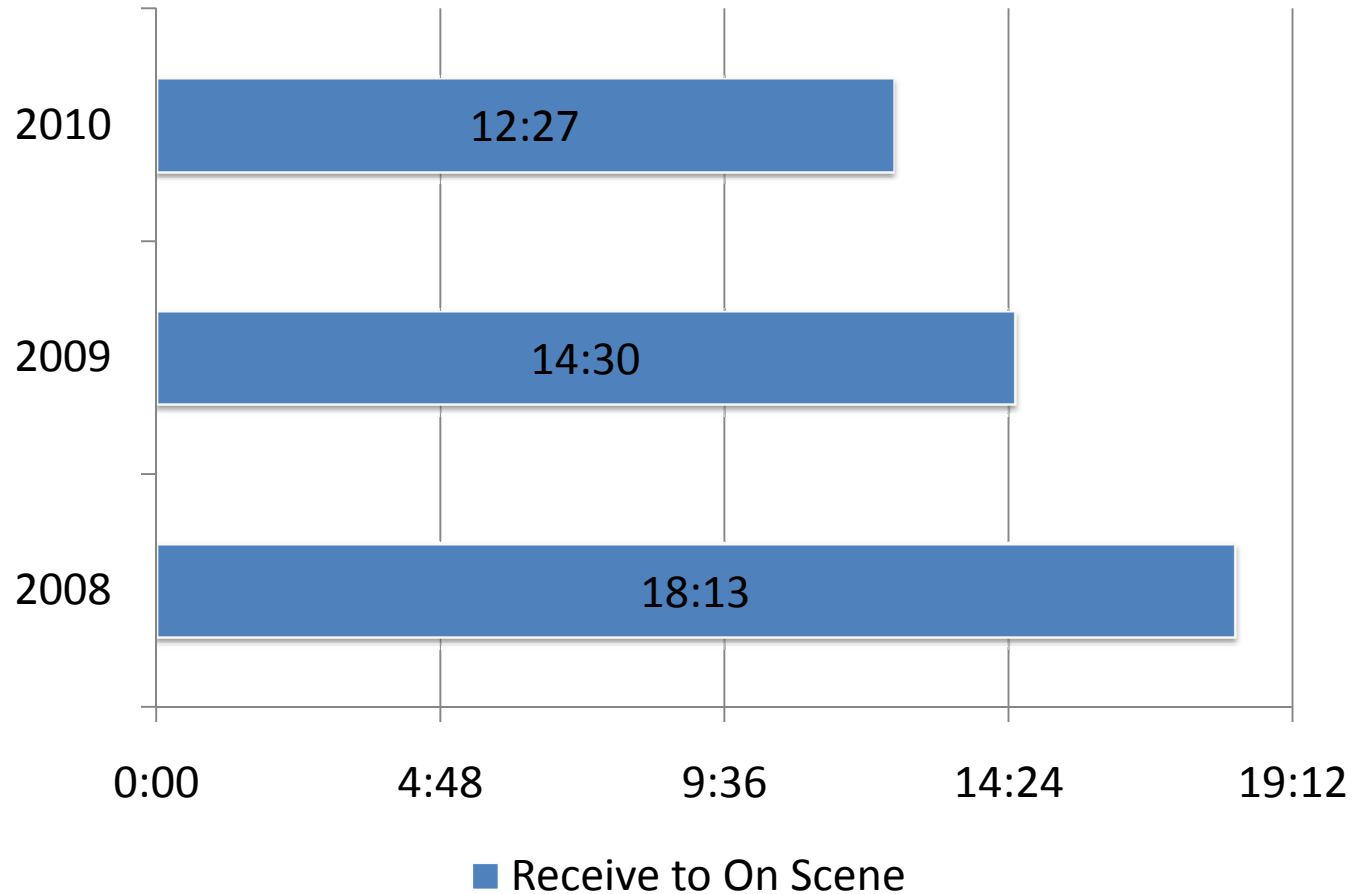
Response Time – Priority 2
