- Last spring Town Council approved the hiring of a General Manager and \$1 million in additional capital improvements at HPEC.
- CIP projects complete
 - Enhanced lighting
 - Drainage improvements
 - Marquee sign
 - West side bleachers
 - 200 shed row barns
- Revenue Goal FY10-11 \$120,000
 - Revenues as of May 1, 2011 \$184,000
- Marketing Plan for FY11-12



- New General Manager
 - After an extensive search Tim Lynch was selected as the new GM of HPEC; Tim's first day with Queen Creek was August 16, 2010.
- New contracts, new events, new exposure for HPEC
 - Since Tim's arrival several new contracts have been signed including the 5 year contract with the AzCHA.

- Events
 - Ranch Sorting produced by HPEC
 - This event allows for participation from all skill levels; family oriented.
- Sponsorships
 - Several sponsorships have been secured. These include A to Z Rentals; Jim's Ace Hardware and Kietek Manufacturing. Others are currently being considered.



- Events/Contracts in negotiation
 - Negotiations are underway with several event producers.

 - 144

- Plans for next fiscal year
 - Revenue projections for FY11-12- \$460,000
