Richard Brockmyer, representing the ASU students (MUEP Capstone Studio) presented the groups capstone project "Town Center Development Plan". The project included an analysis on the economic & demographics of Queen Creek; modes of transportation and time commuting; land use plans, both current and planned; activity areas including a transit center, entertainment district, hospitality area, convention center and heritage district. The plan also included seven "gateway" areas identifying entrance to the Town Center. Mr. Brockmyer concluded the presentation with suggested implementation strategies.

Council commended the students on the quality of the project. They also asked Mr. Balmer, Planning Manager, how some of the recommended elements could be included

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in the Town Center Plan. Mr. Balmer responded that the project could be presented to the Town Center Committee for consideration and recommendations.
