Evolution of Citizen Leadership

- Changing/adding sessions
 - Education
 - Public Safety/Communications
- Quantity of participants has decreased as the community has become more established
- Moved to an online format vs. printed books (lowered costs)



Time for an Update!

- Community growth pattern has changed over the years
- Fewer new residents moving in
- Small class size allows for more interaction among participants and with Town staff
- Refresh presentations to use less PowerPoint
